- DBEDT subscribes to Vision Insight's Responsible Travelers Segment databases for the State of Hawai'i (O'ahu, Maui, Kaua'i and Hawai'i Island)
- Consumers are surveyed each day
- DBEDT receives access to new data each week for daily responsible traveler metrics – media-focused, brand health, purchase/intent, and consumer status
- Responsible Traveler Segment
 - Respondents who self-identify as responsible travelers (i.e., wellness focused, environmental impact, culturally minded)

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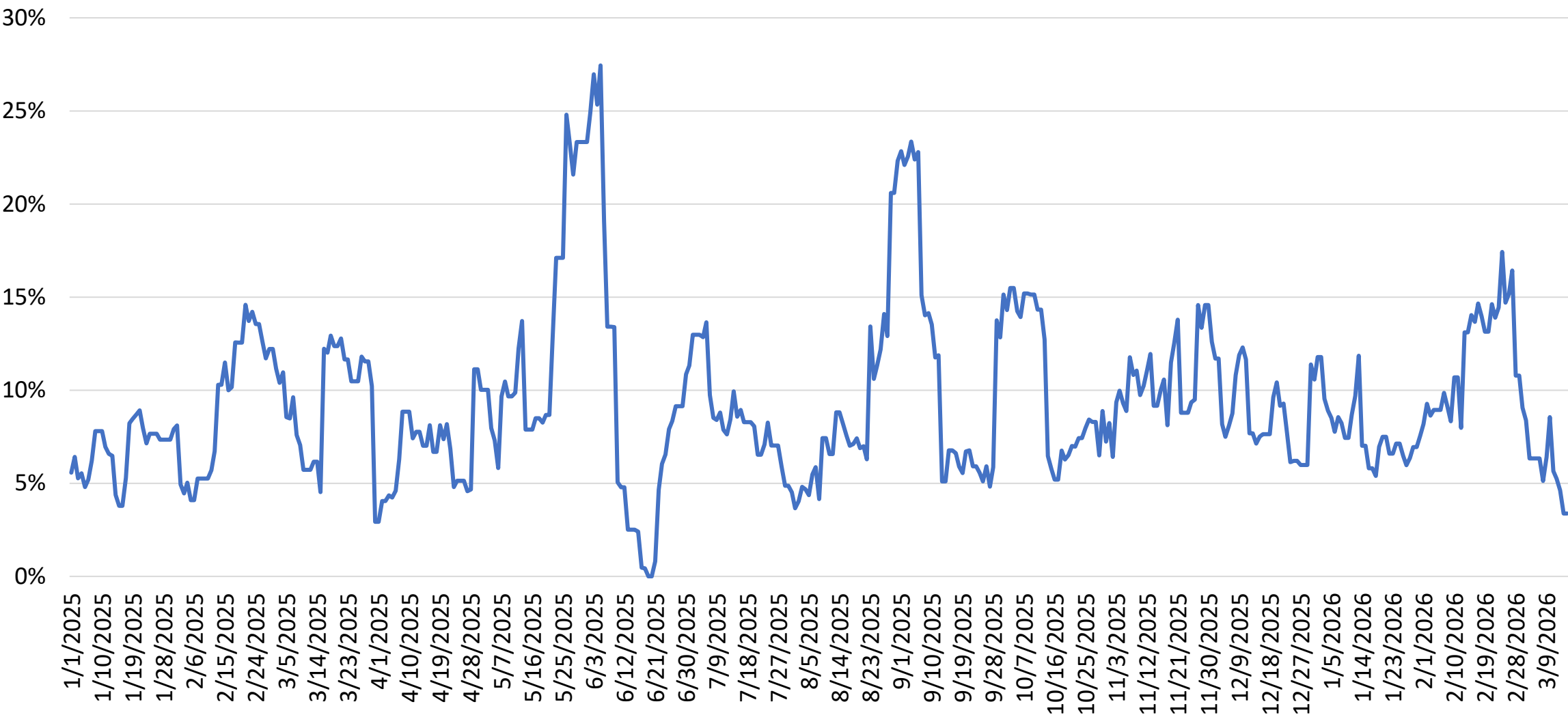


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Australia Responsible Travelers Segment State of Hawai'i

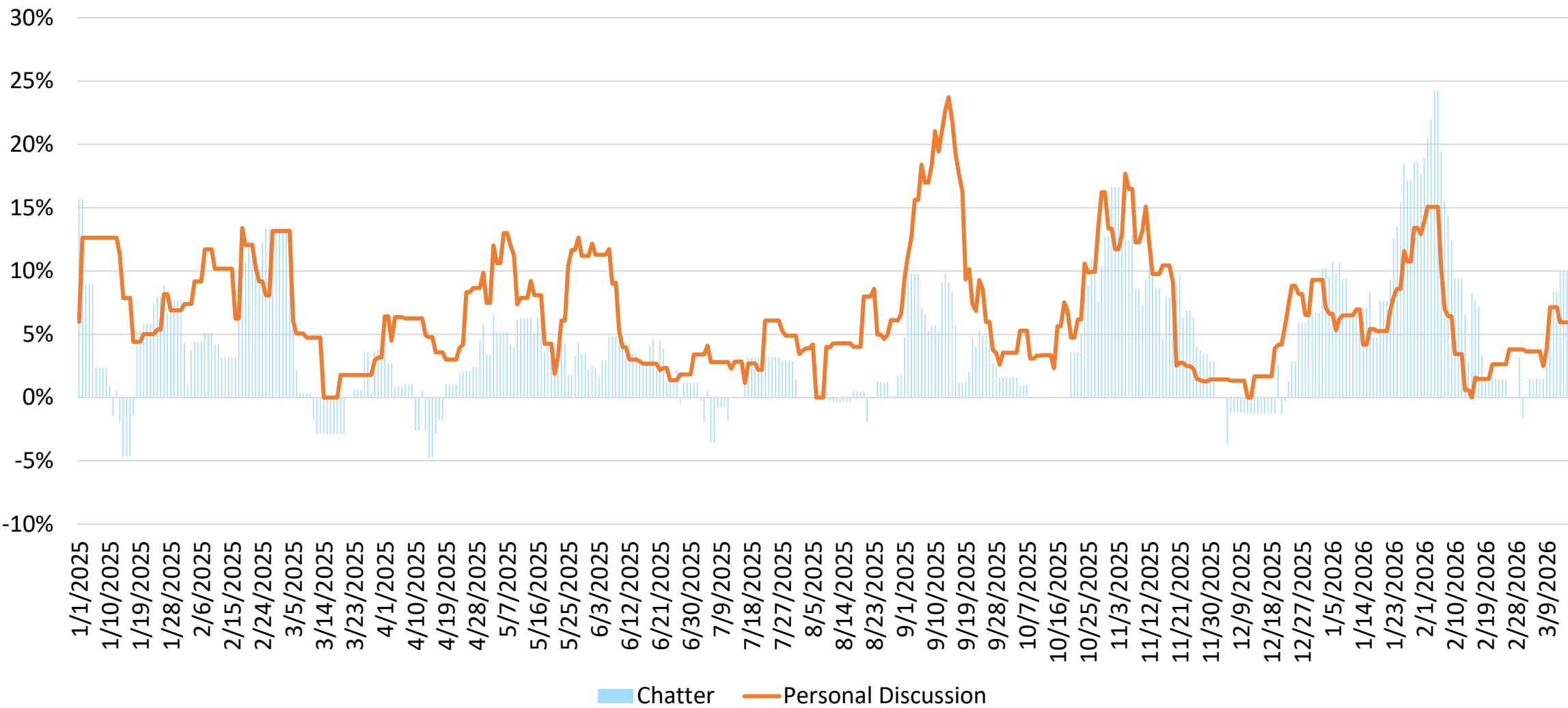

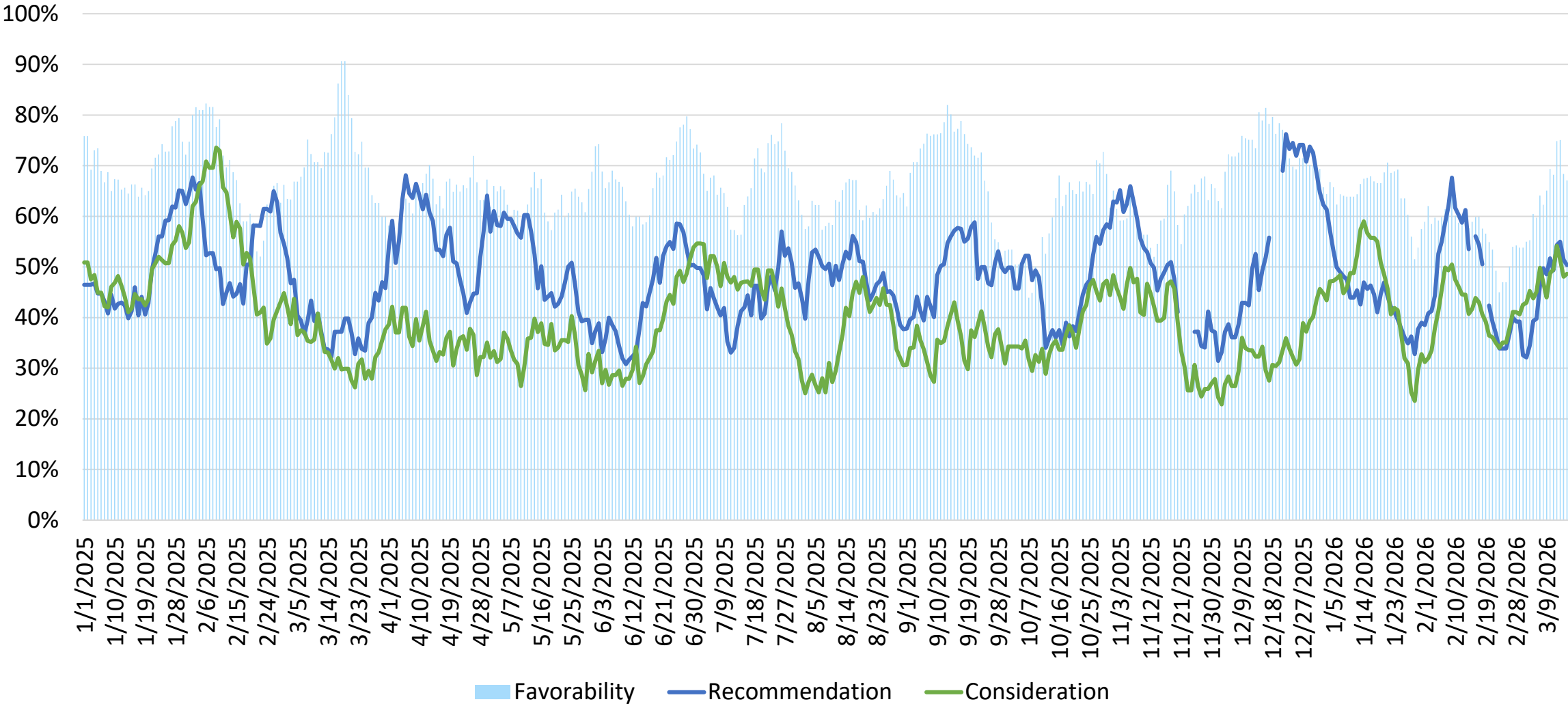

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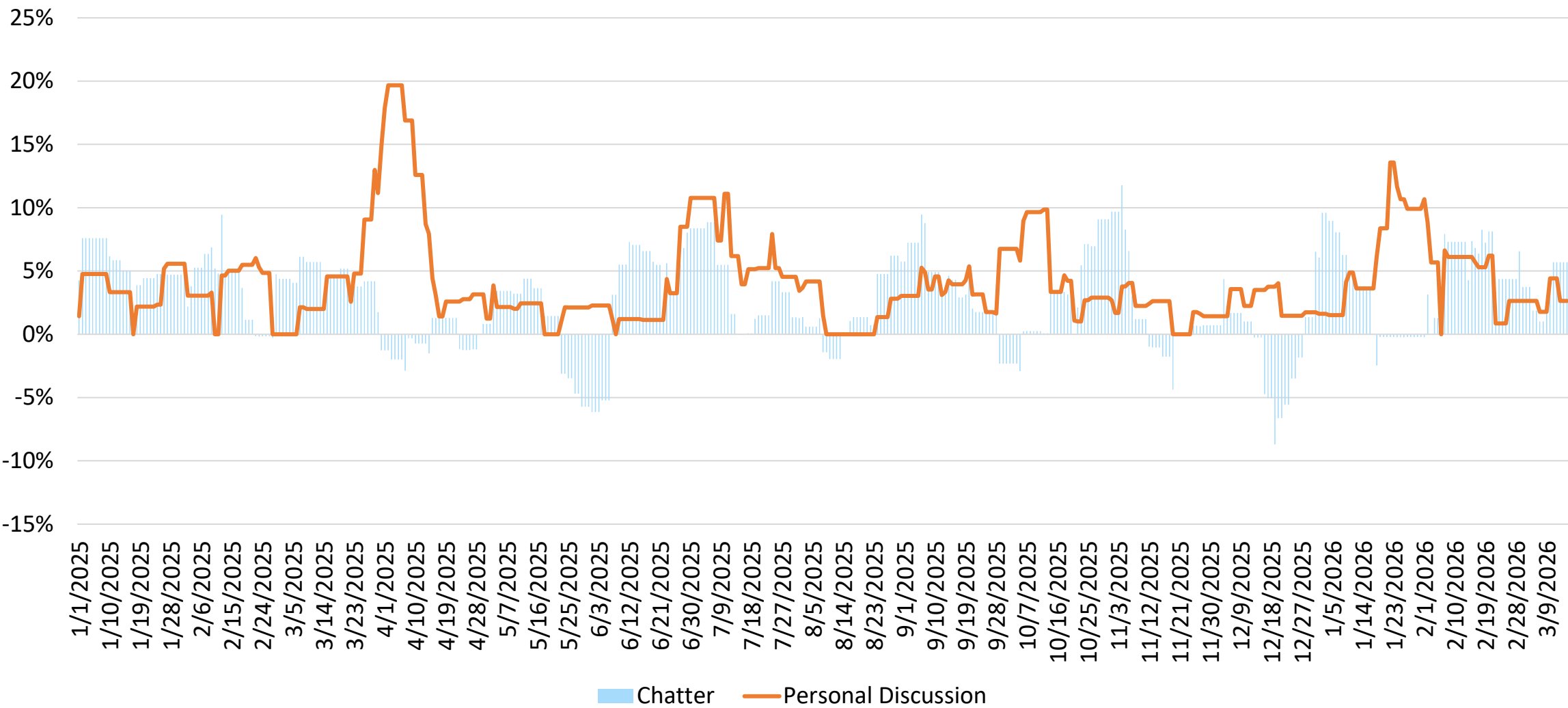

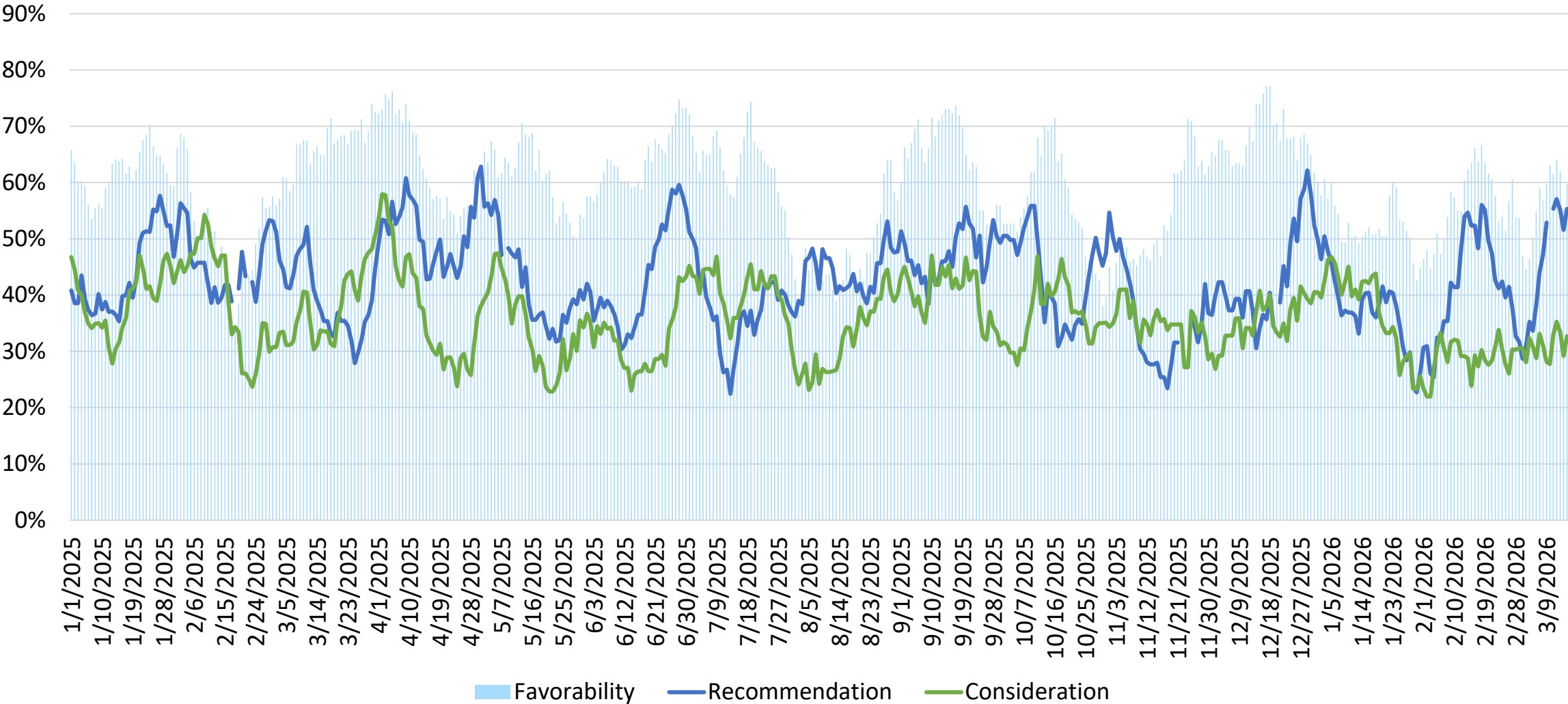

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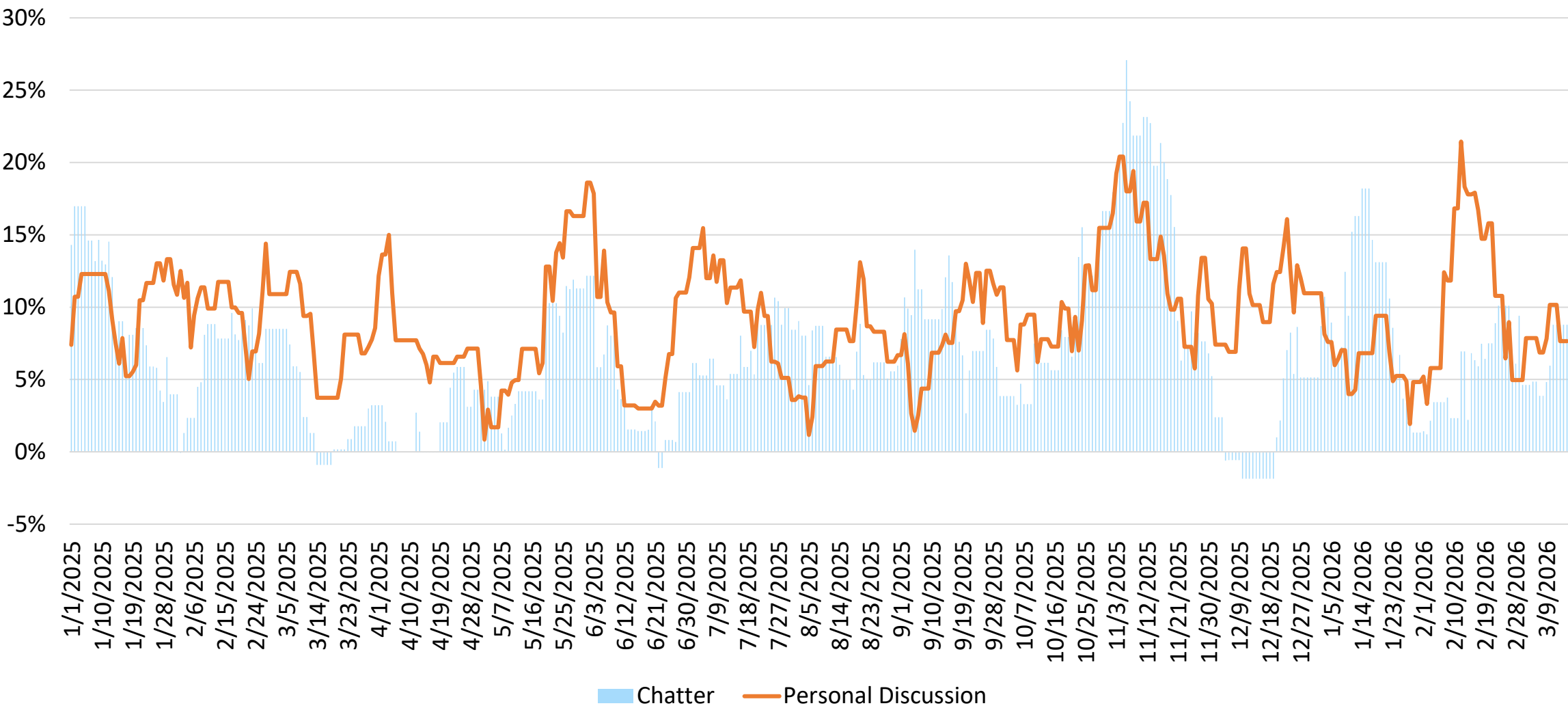

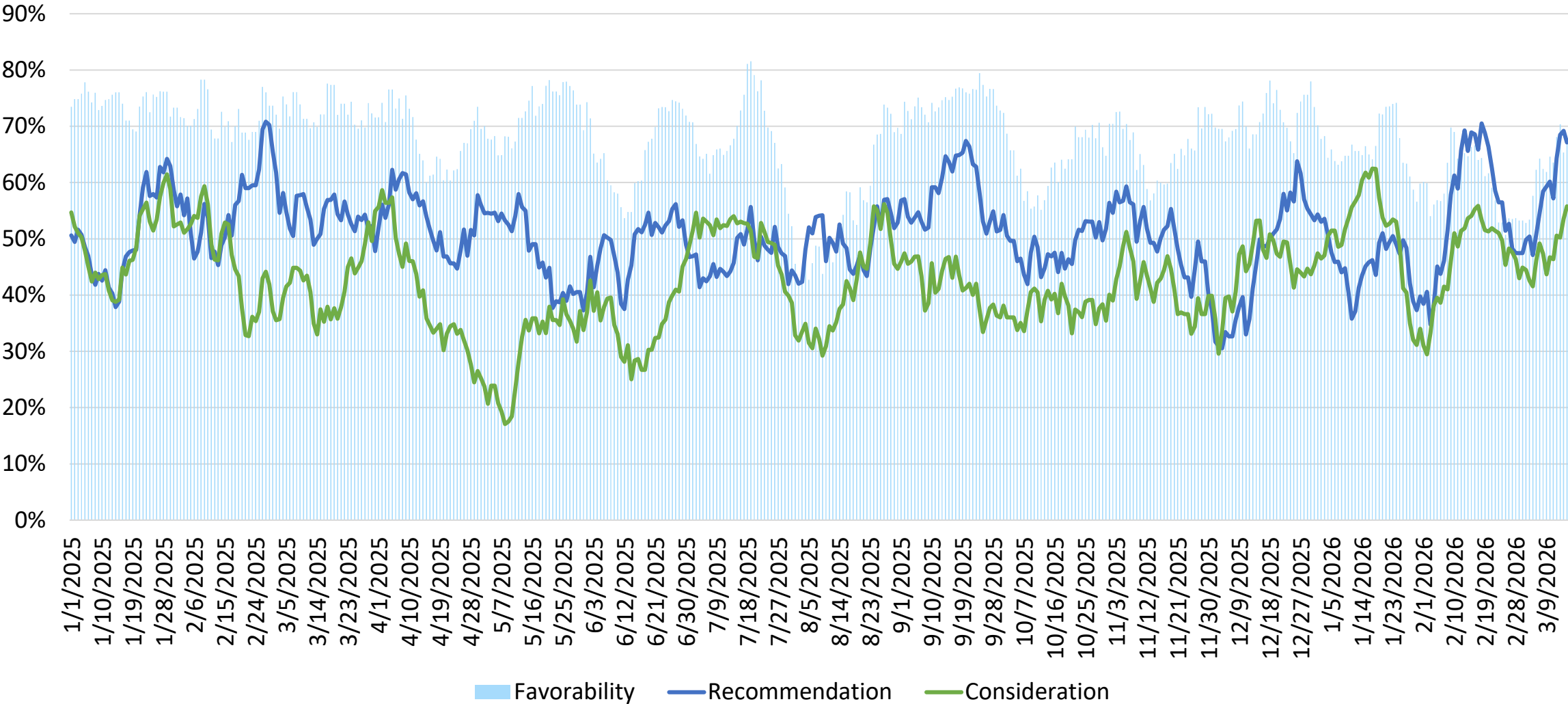

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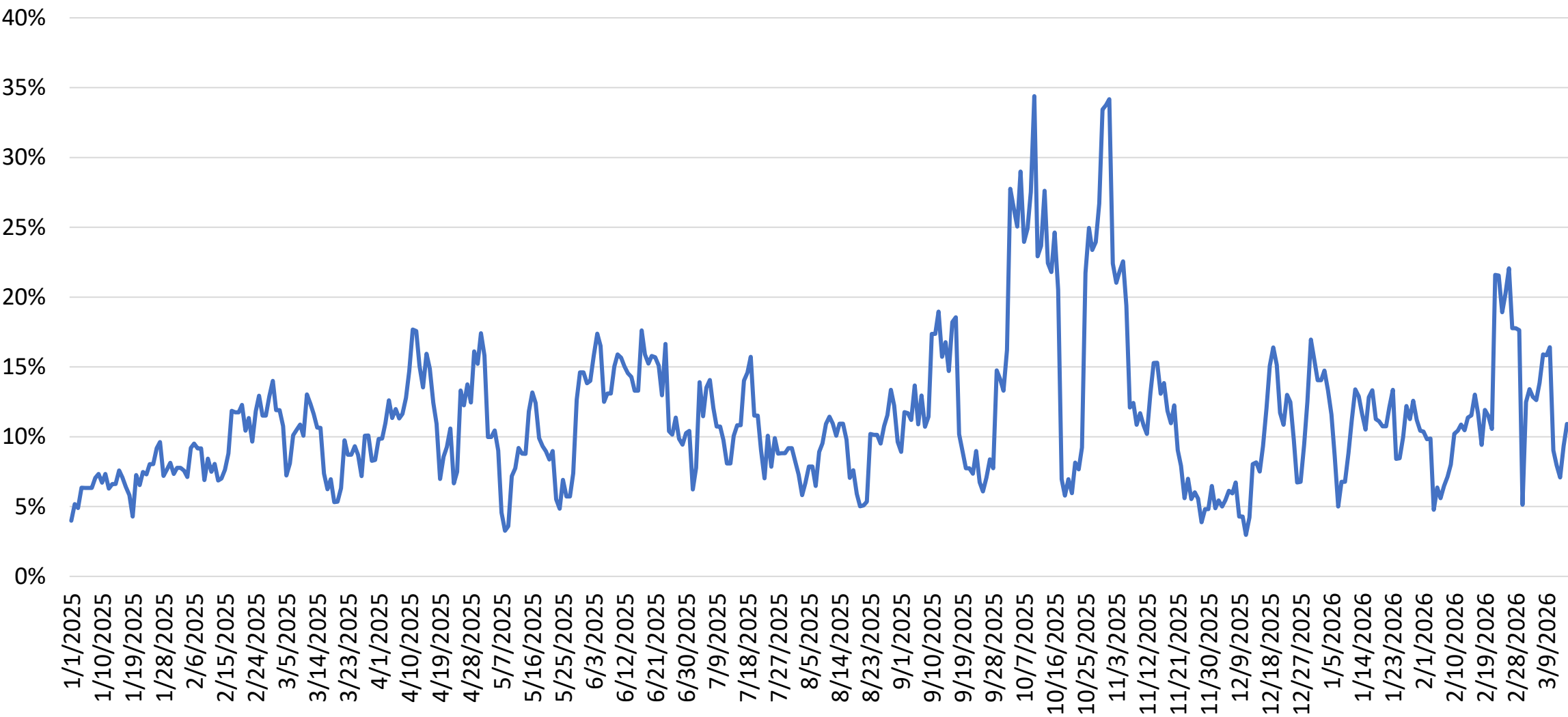

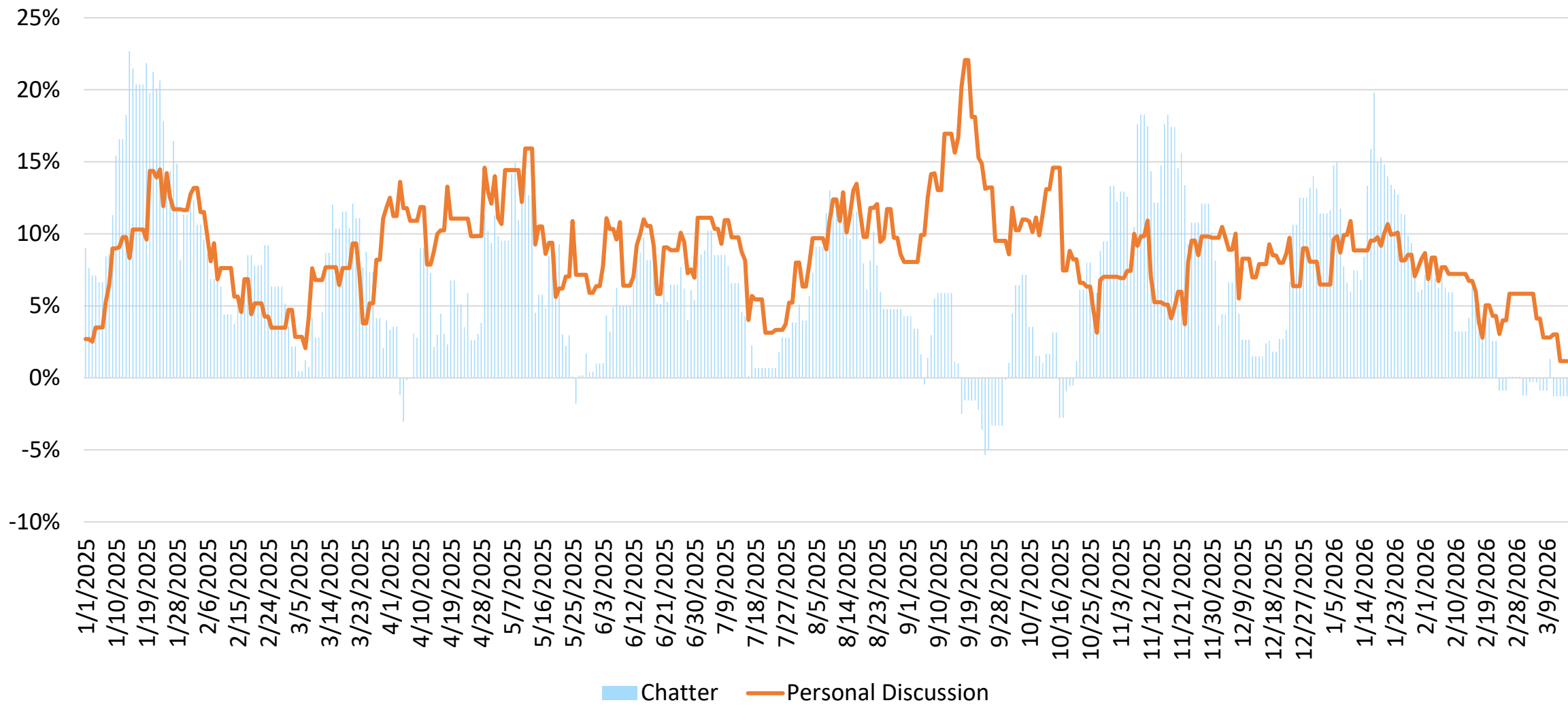

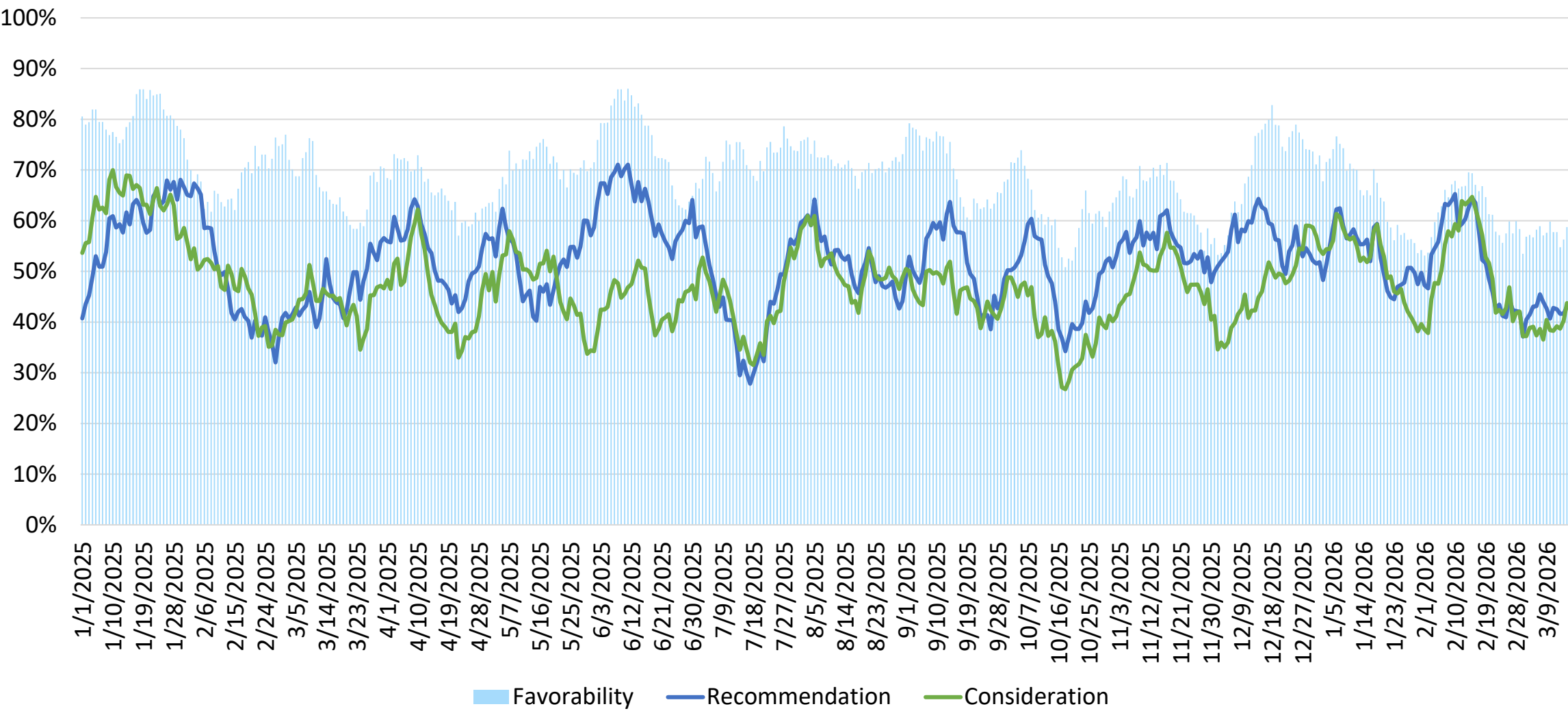
O‘ahu – Chatter (Net) and Personal Discussion Canada Two-Week Moving Average

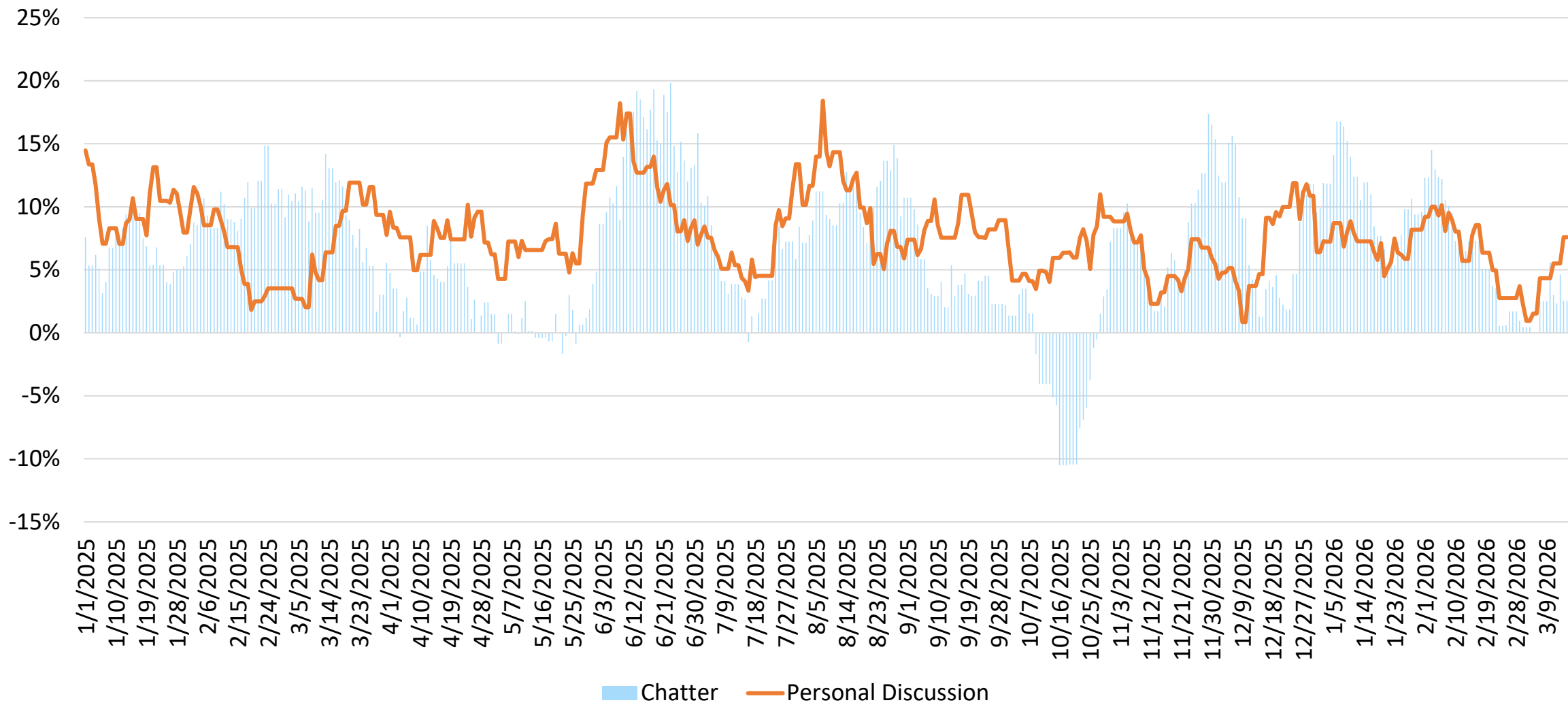

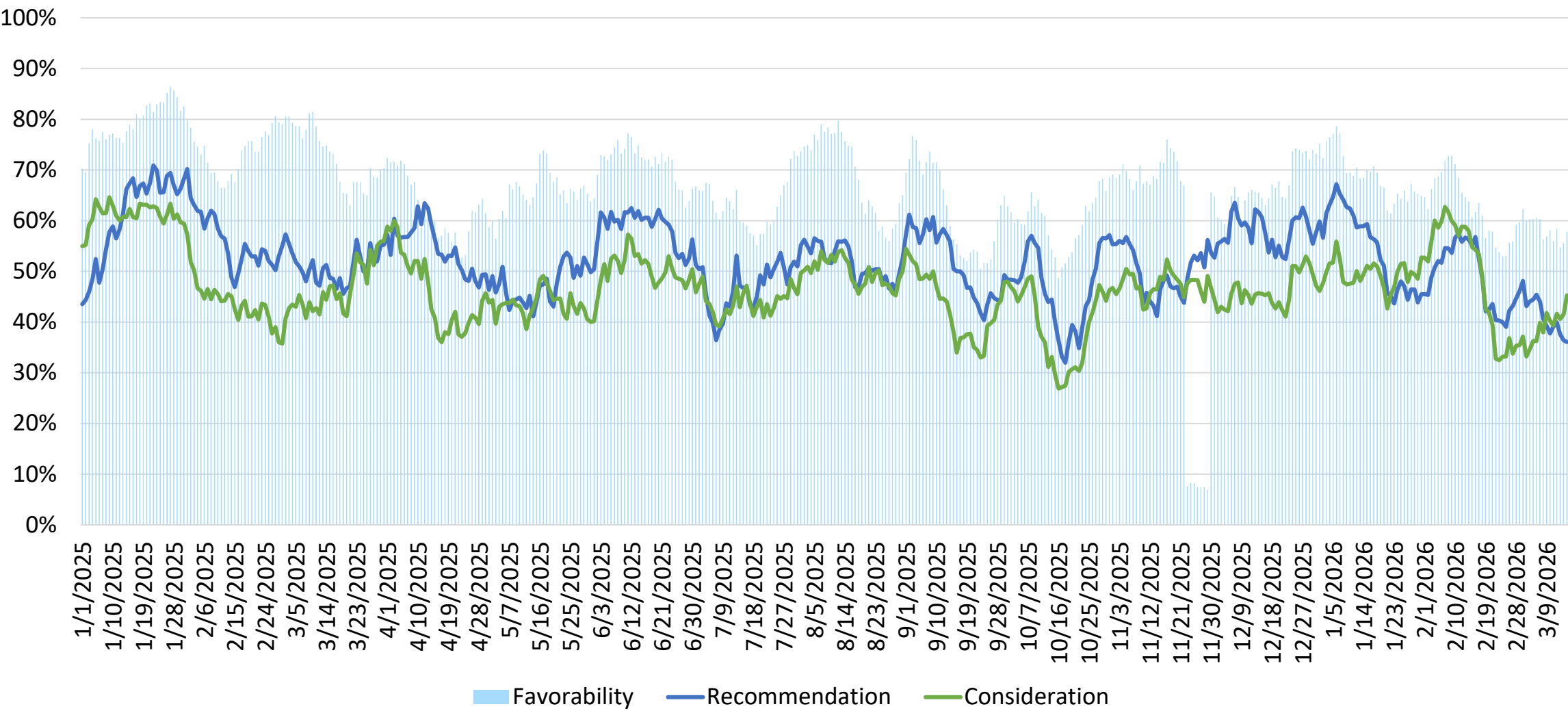
Maui – Chatter (Net) and Personal Discussion Canada Two-Week Moving Average

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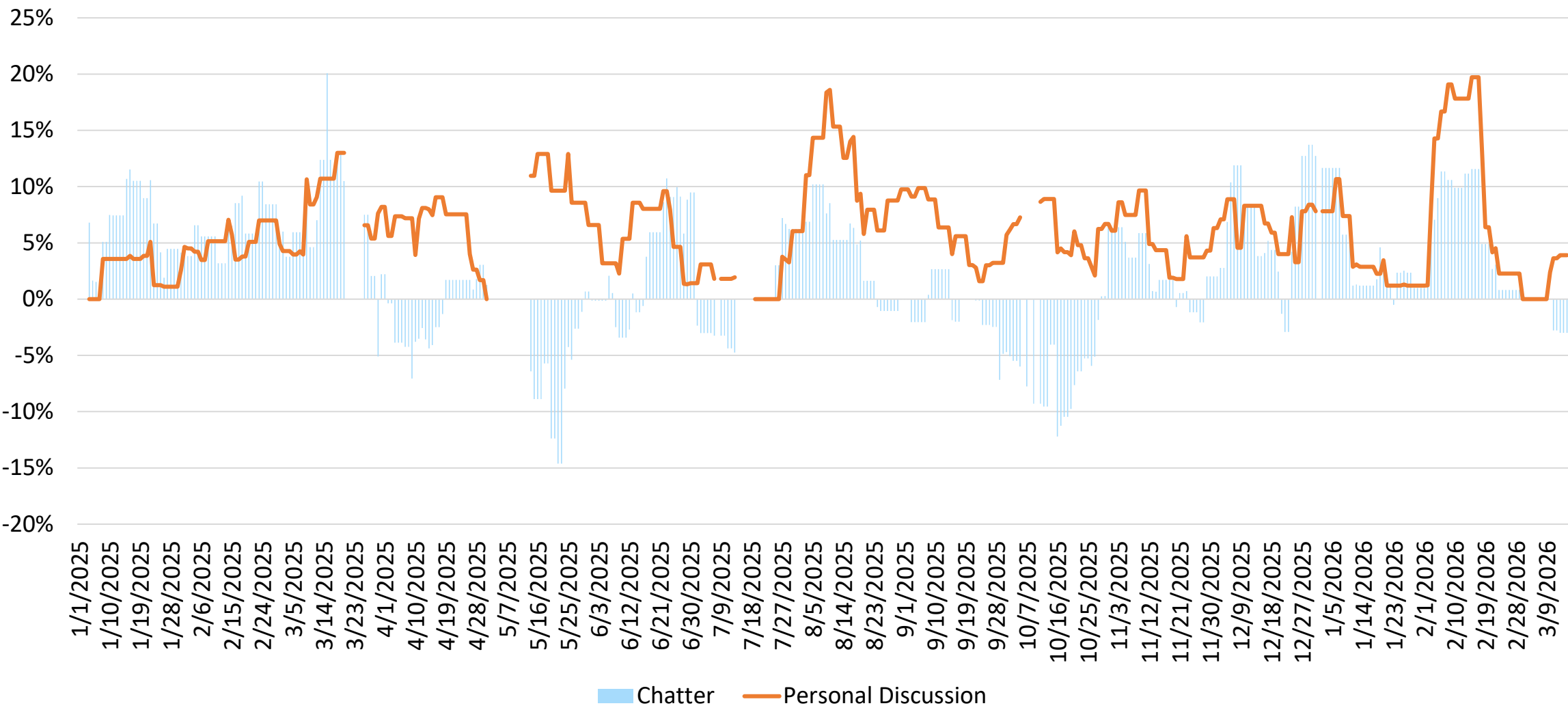

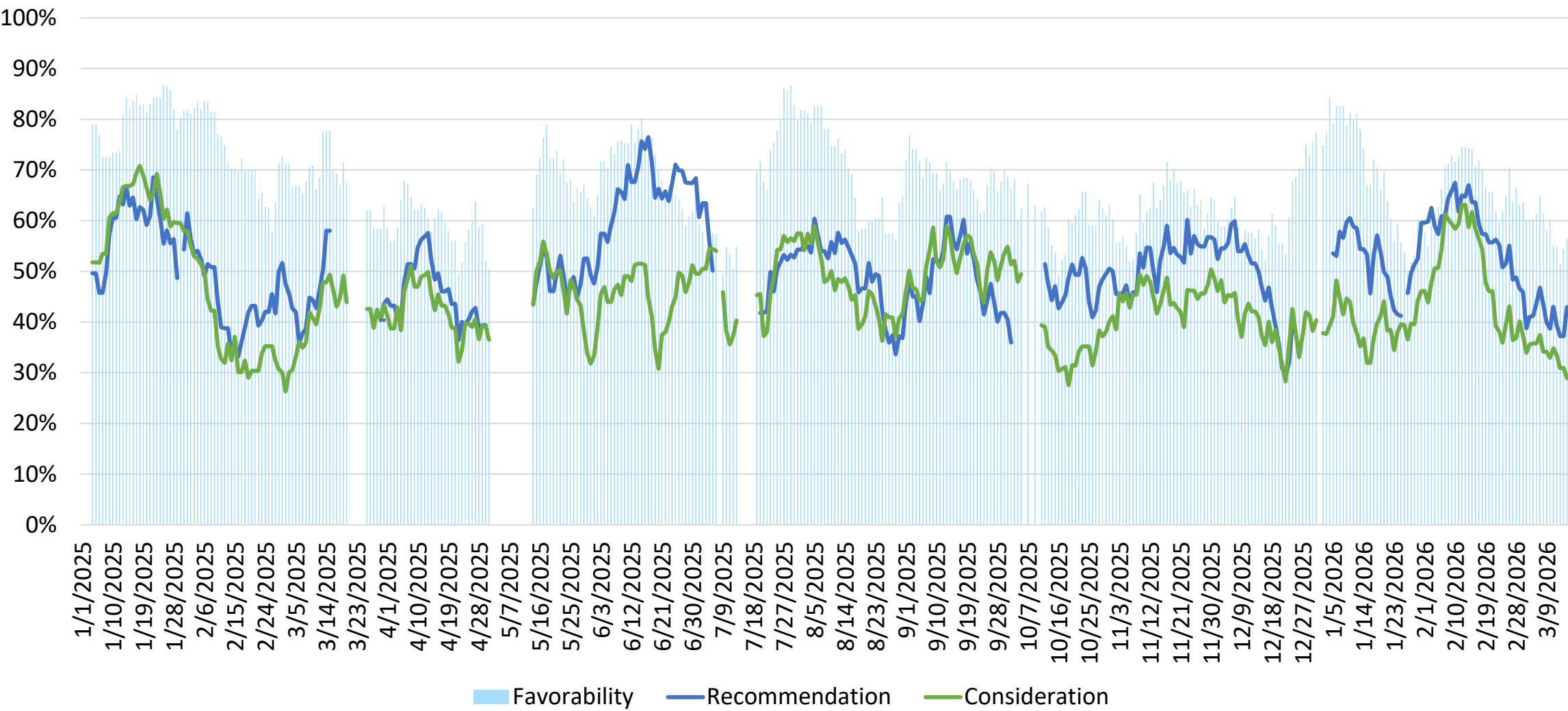
Kaua'i – Chatter (Net) and Personal Discussion Canada Two-Week Moving Average

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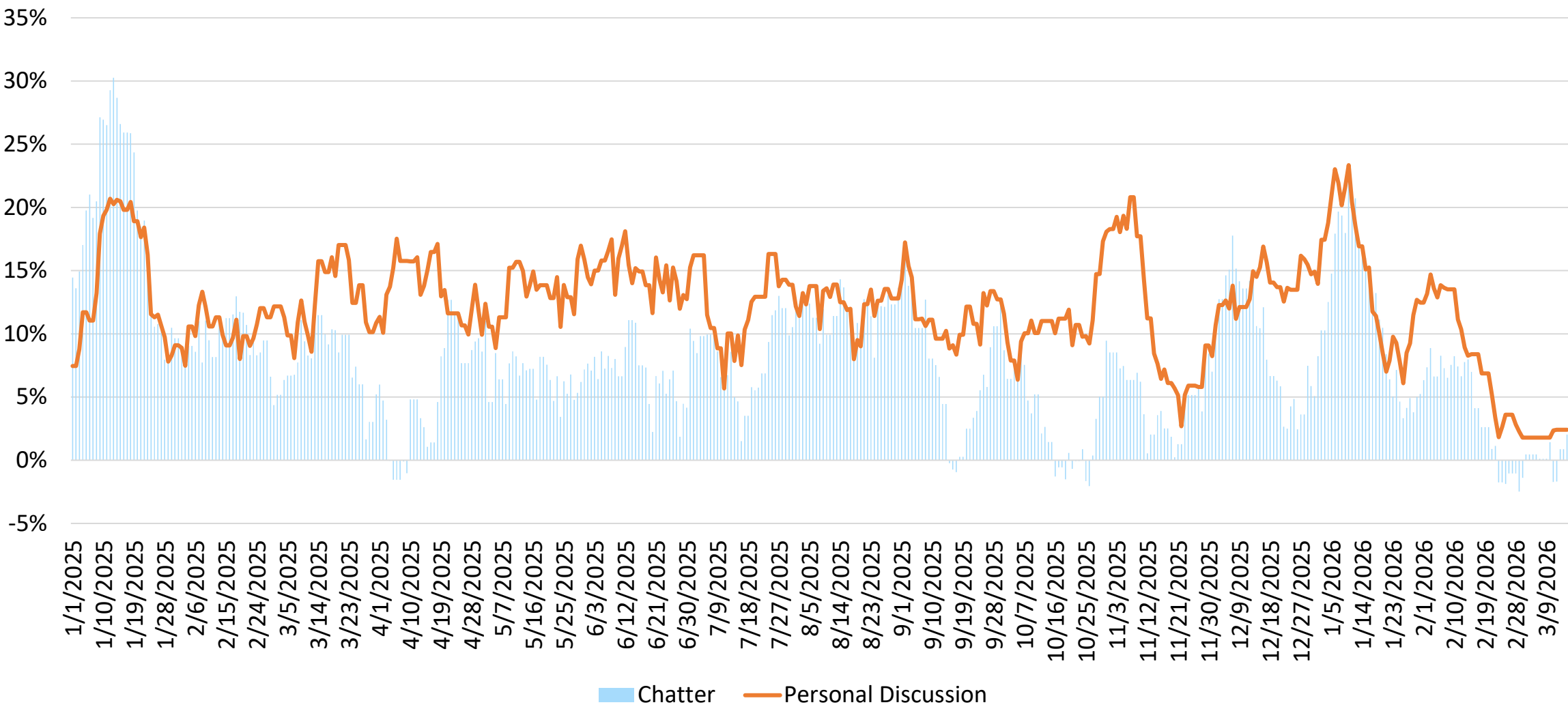

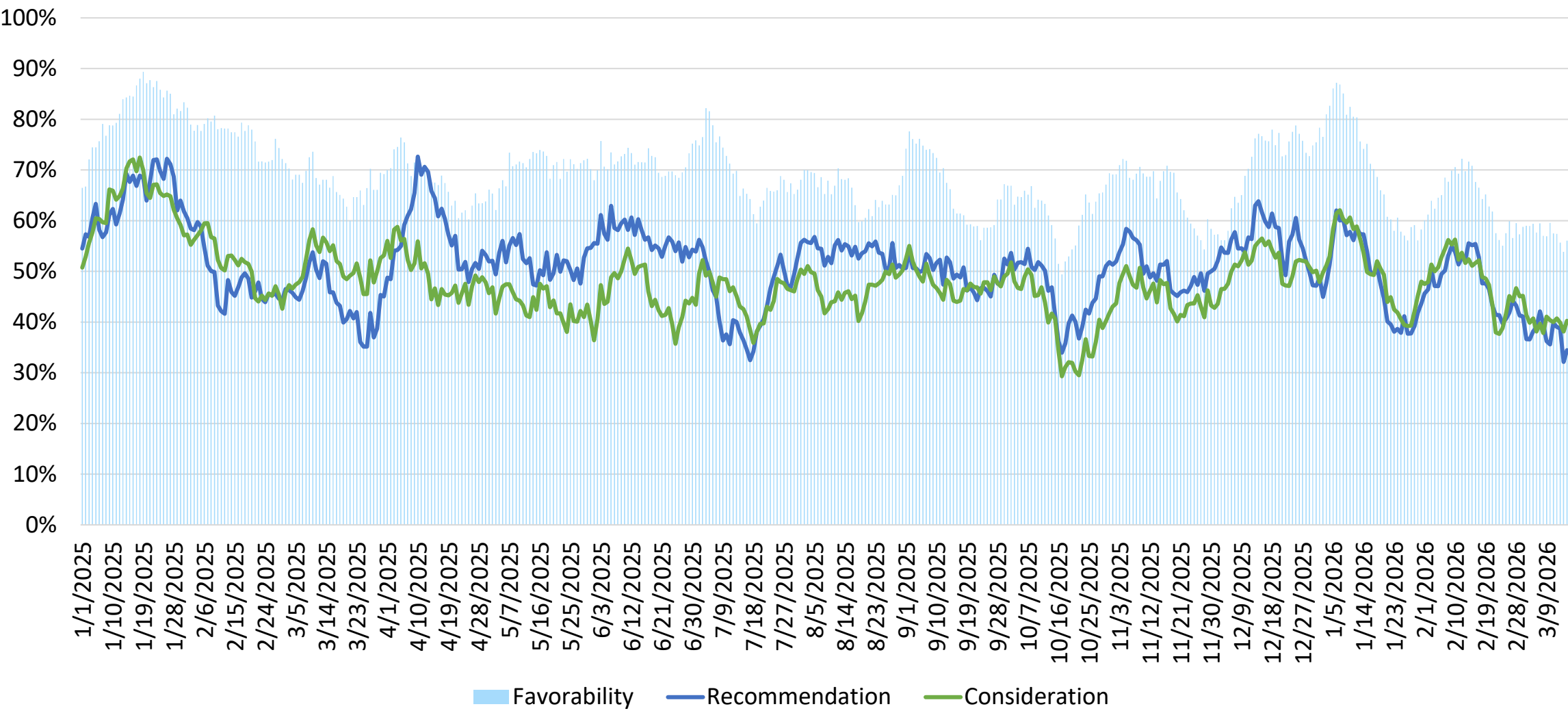

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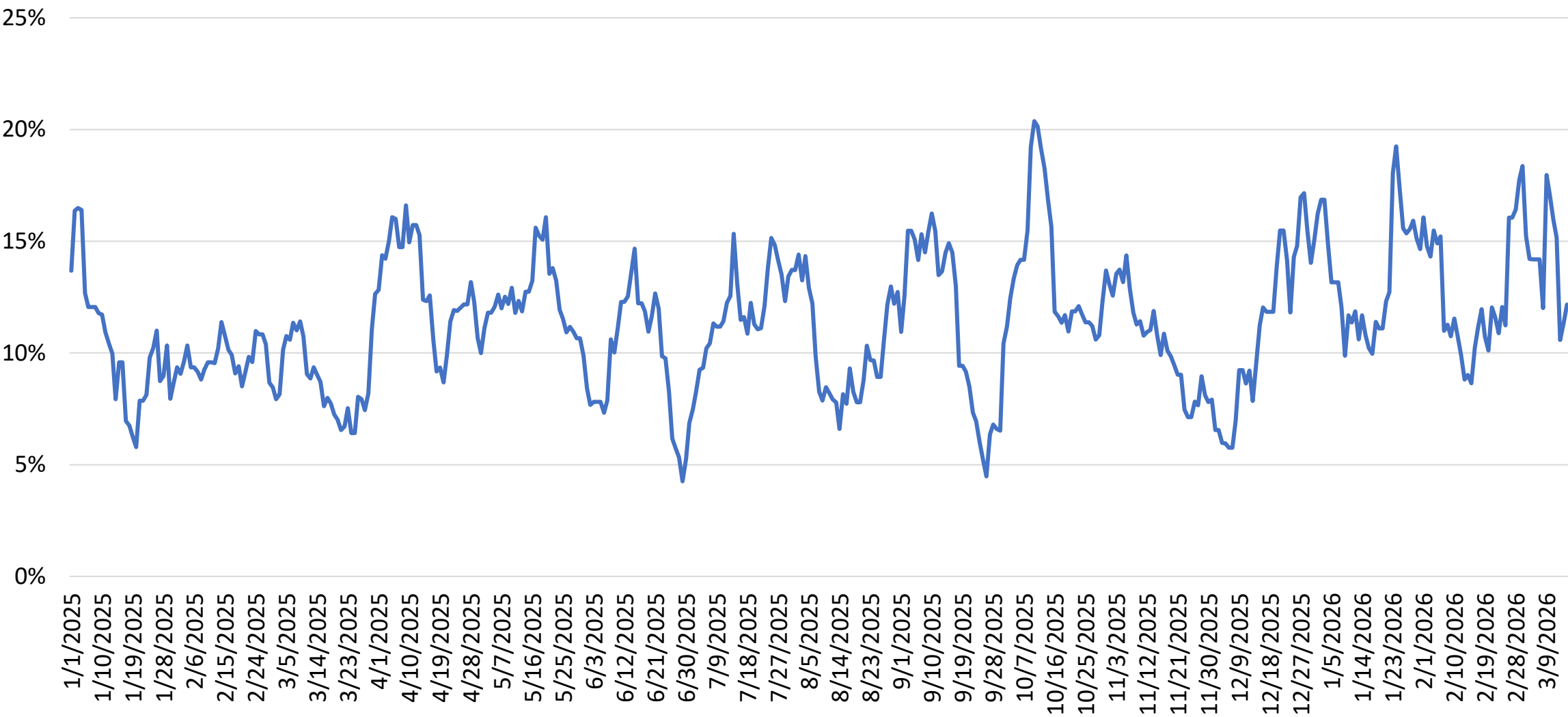


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South Korea Responsible Travelers Segment State of Hawai'i

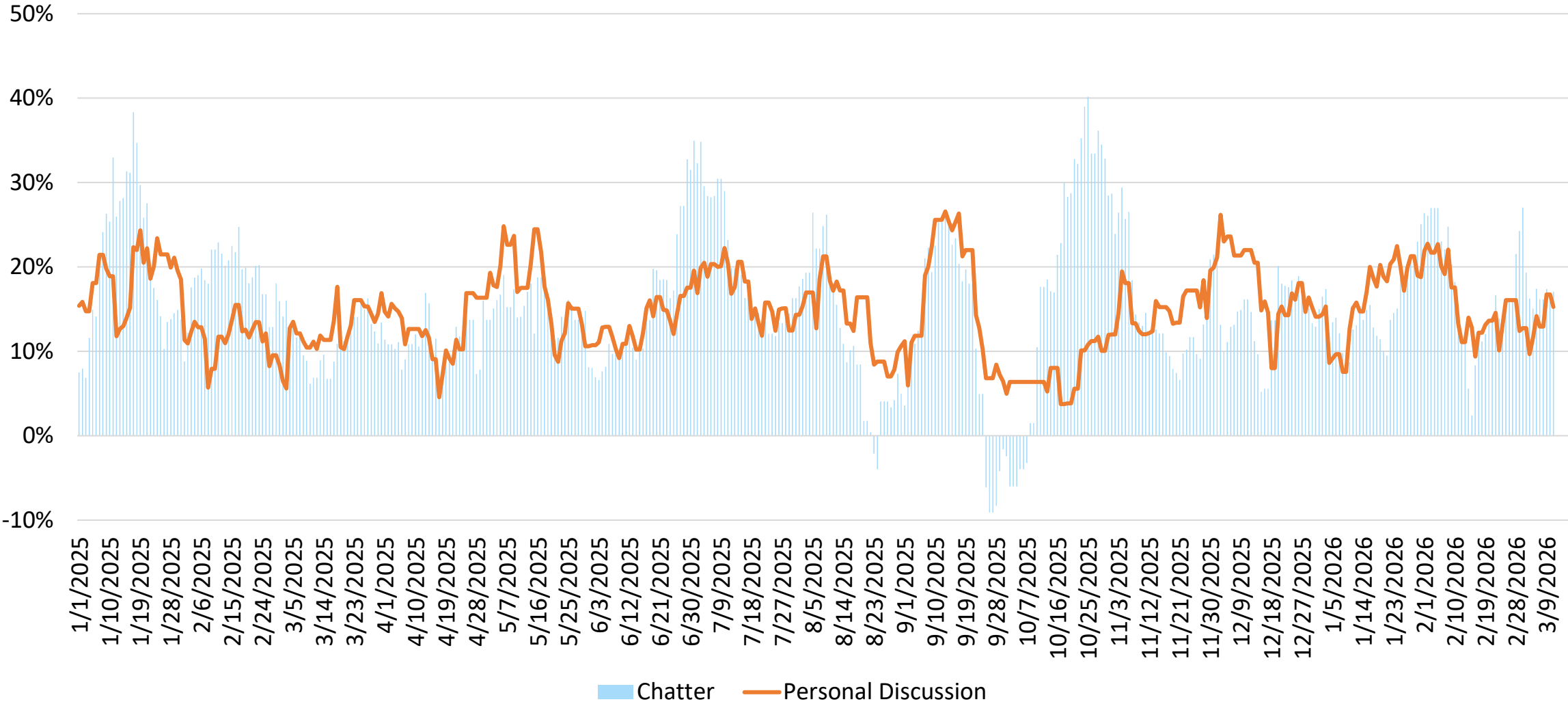

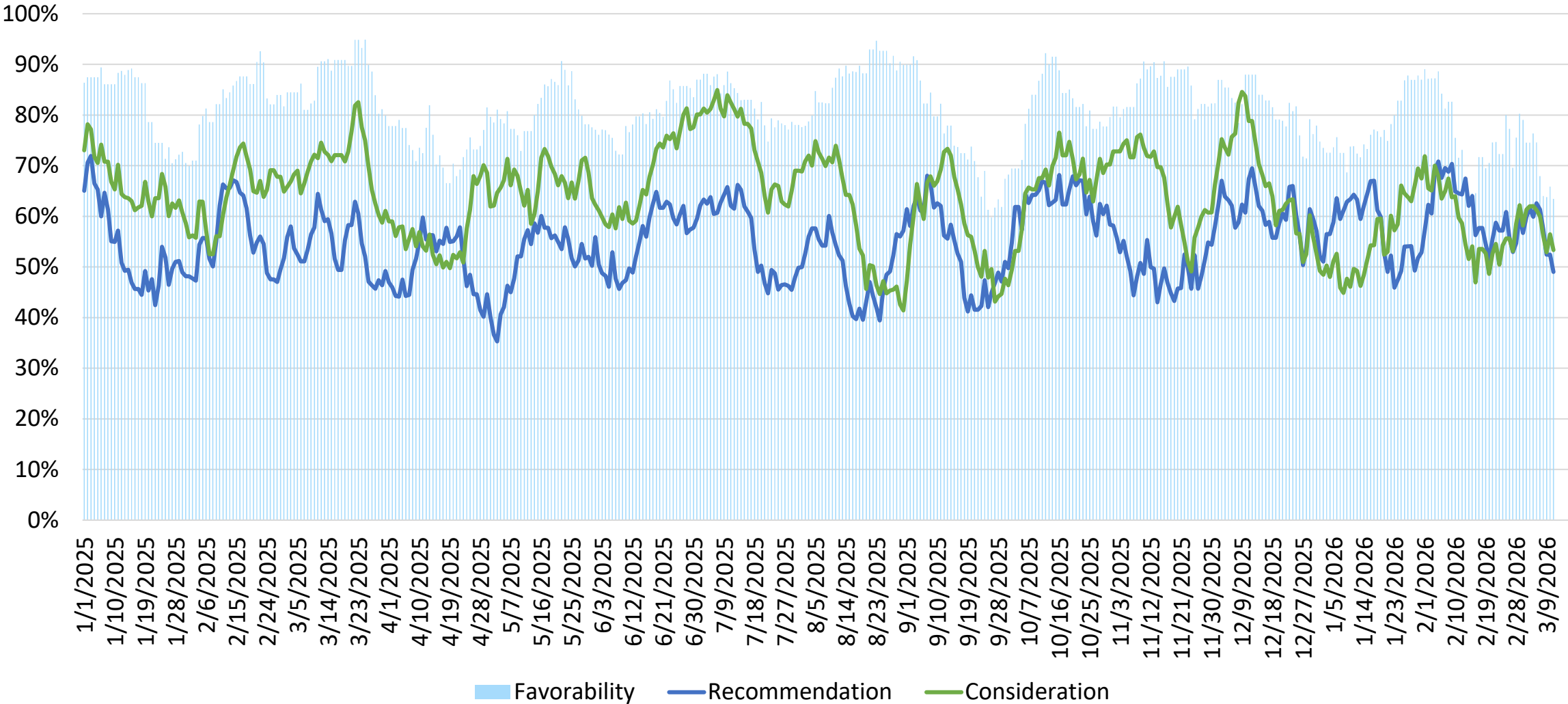
O‘ahu – Chatter (Net) and Personal Discussion South Korea Two-Week Moving Average

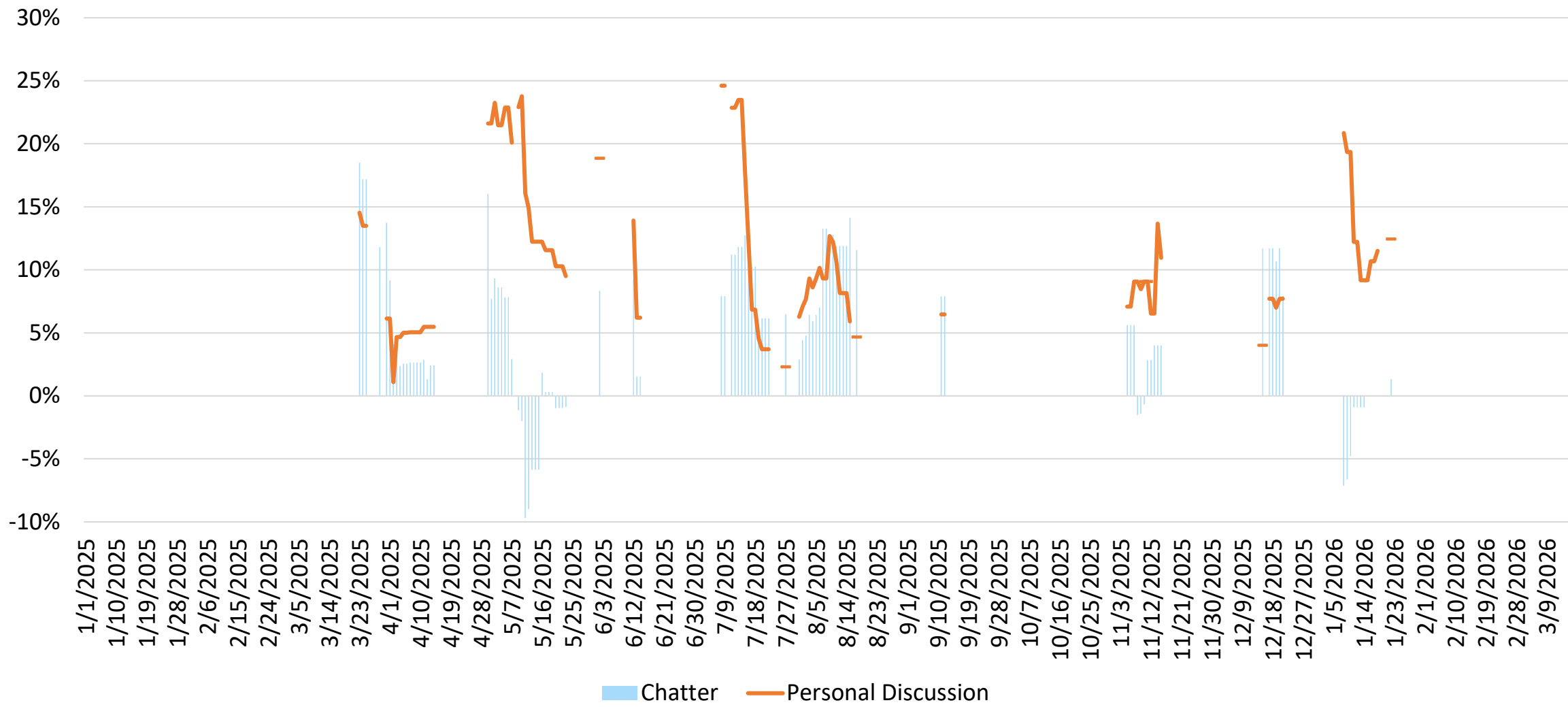

Maui – Chatter (Net) and Personal Discussion South Korea Two-Week Moving Average

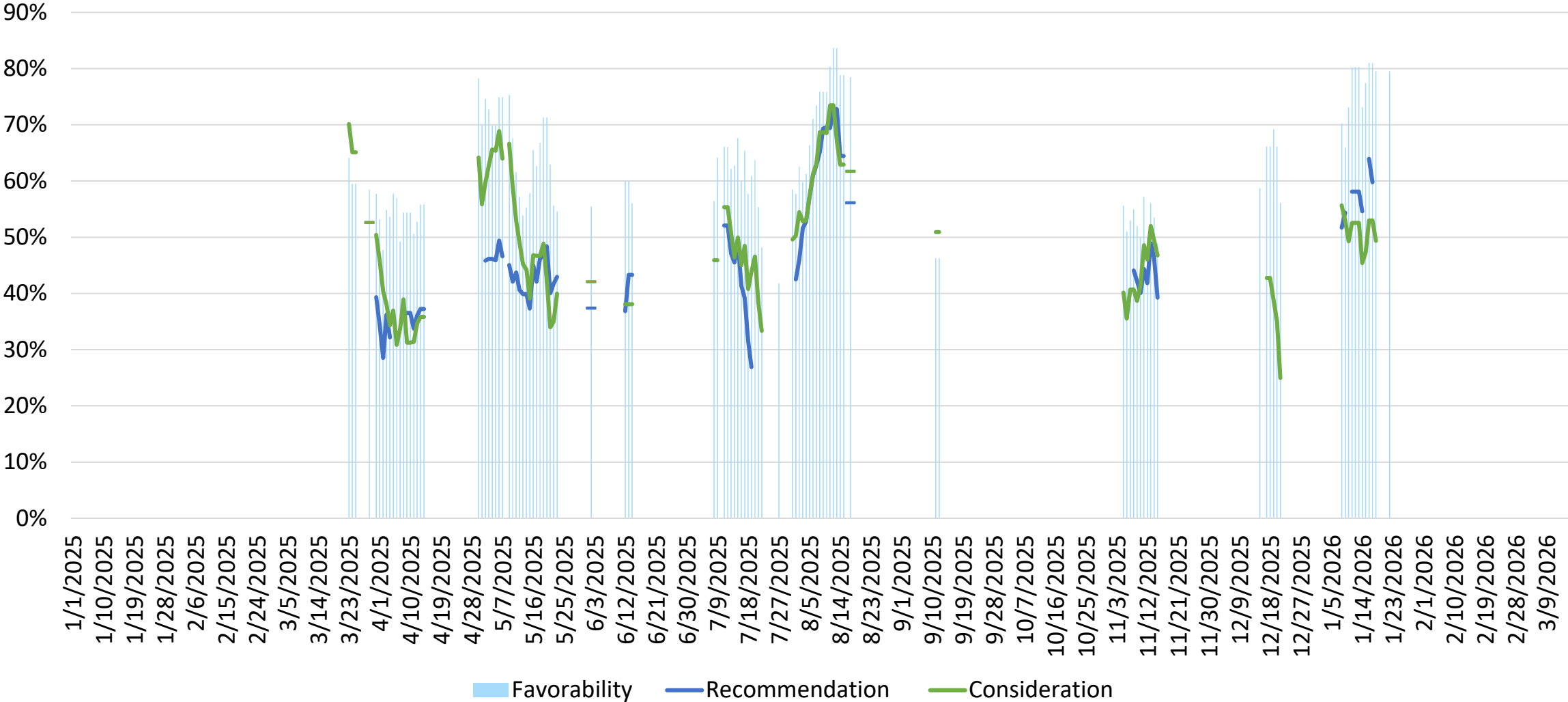

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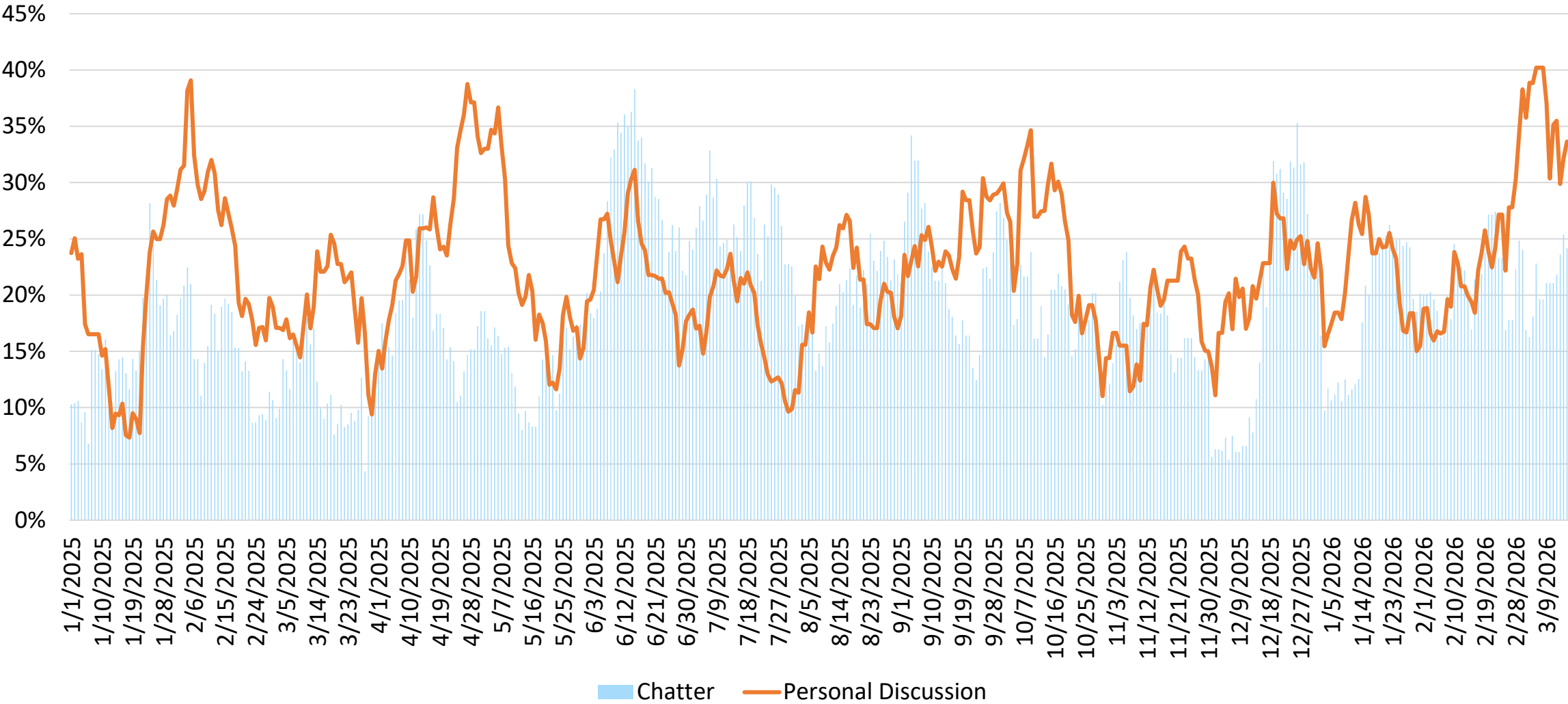

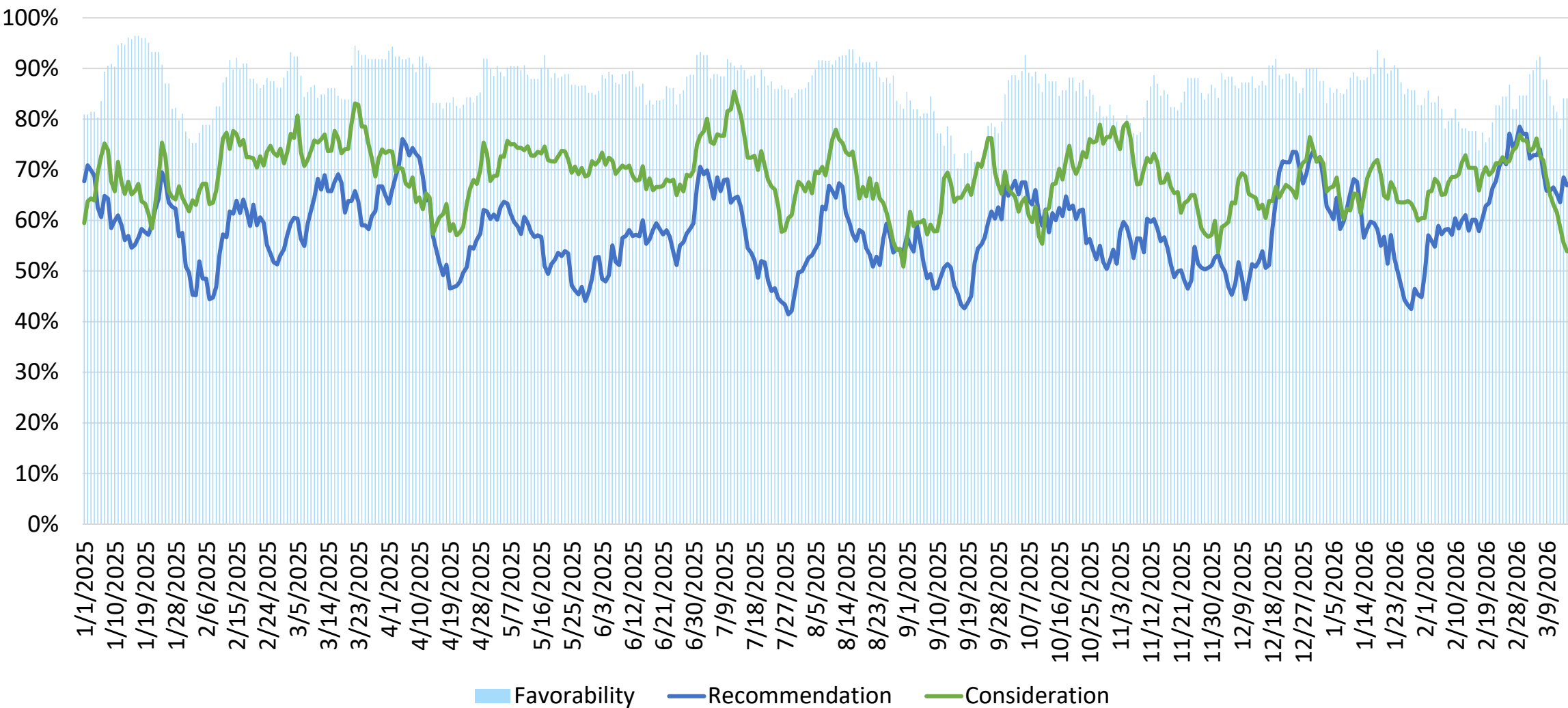

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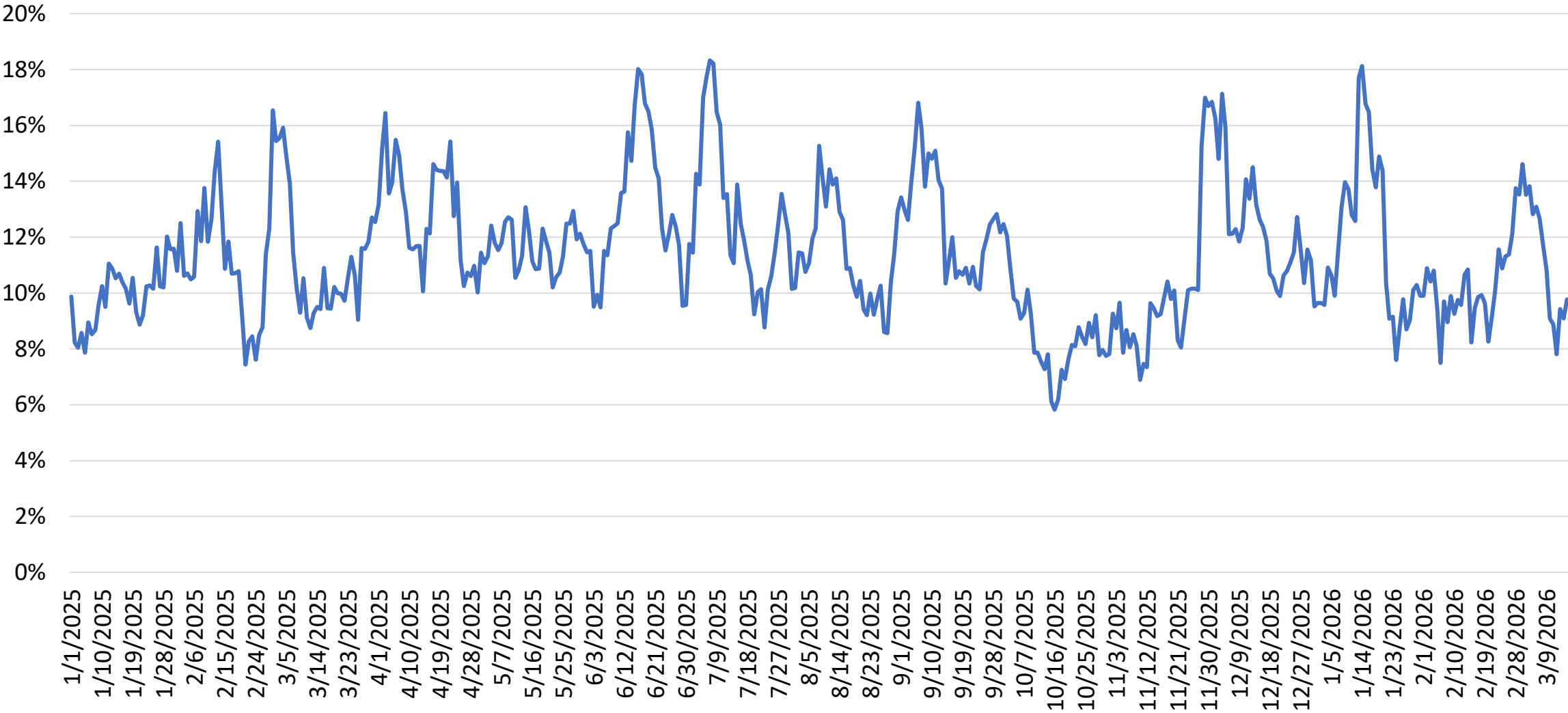

U.S. One-Week Moving Average



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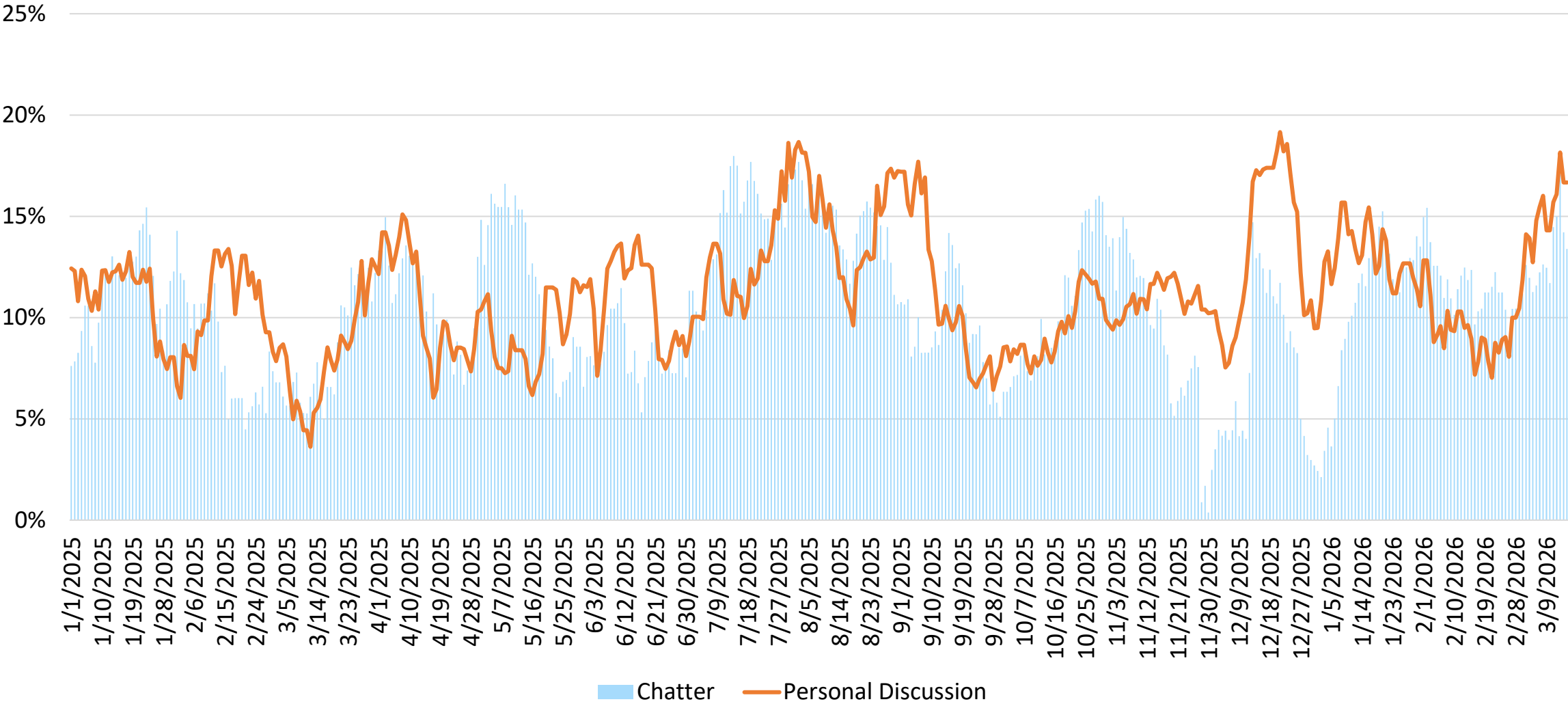

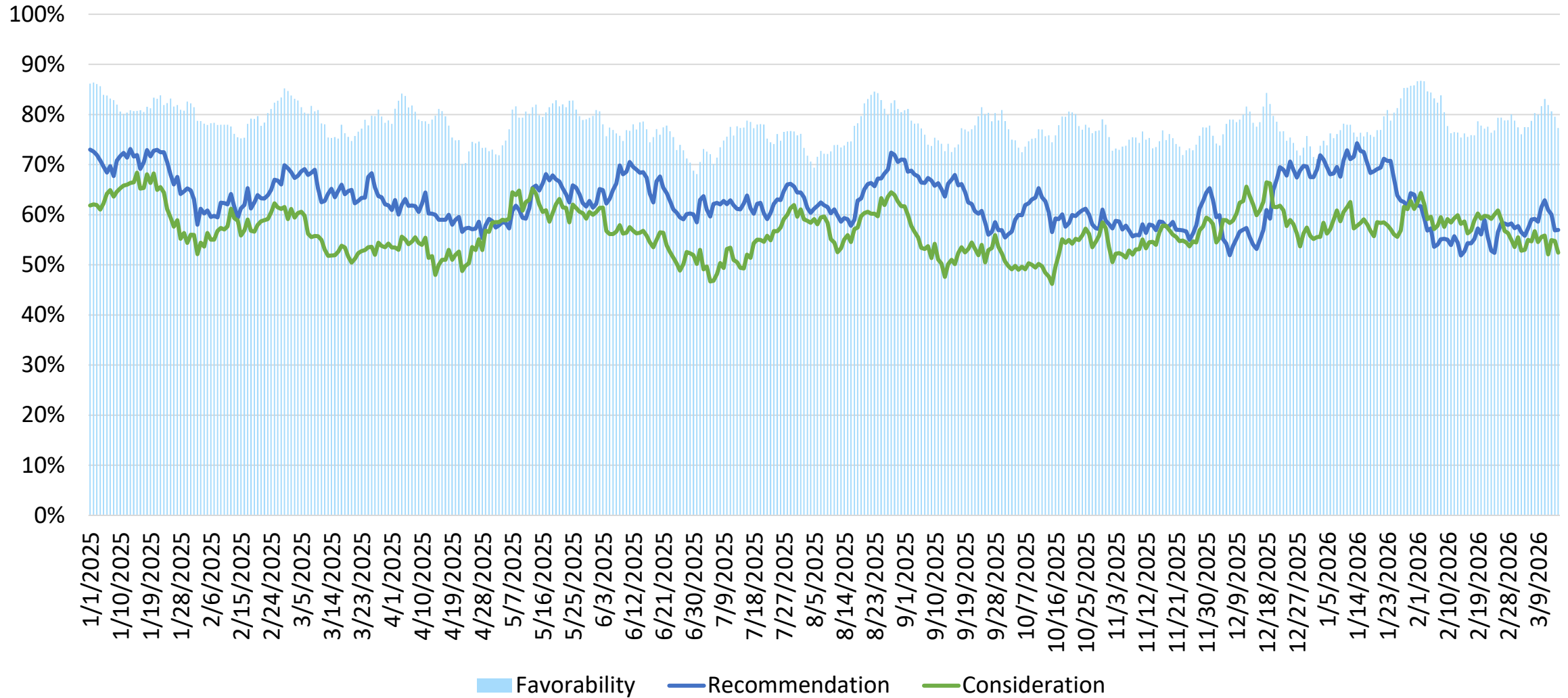
U.S. Two-Week Moving Average

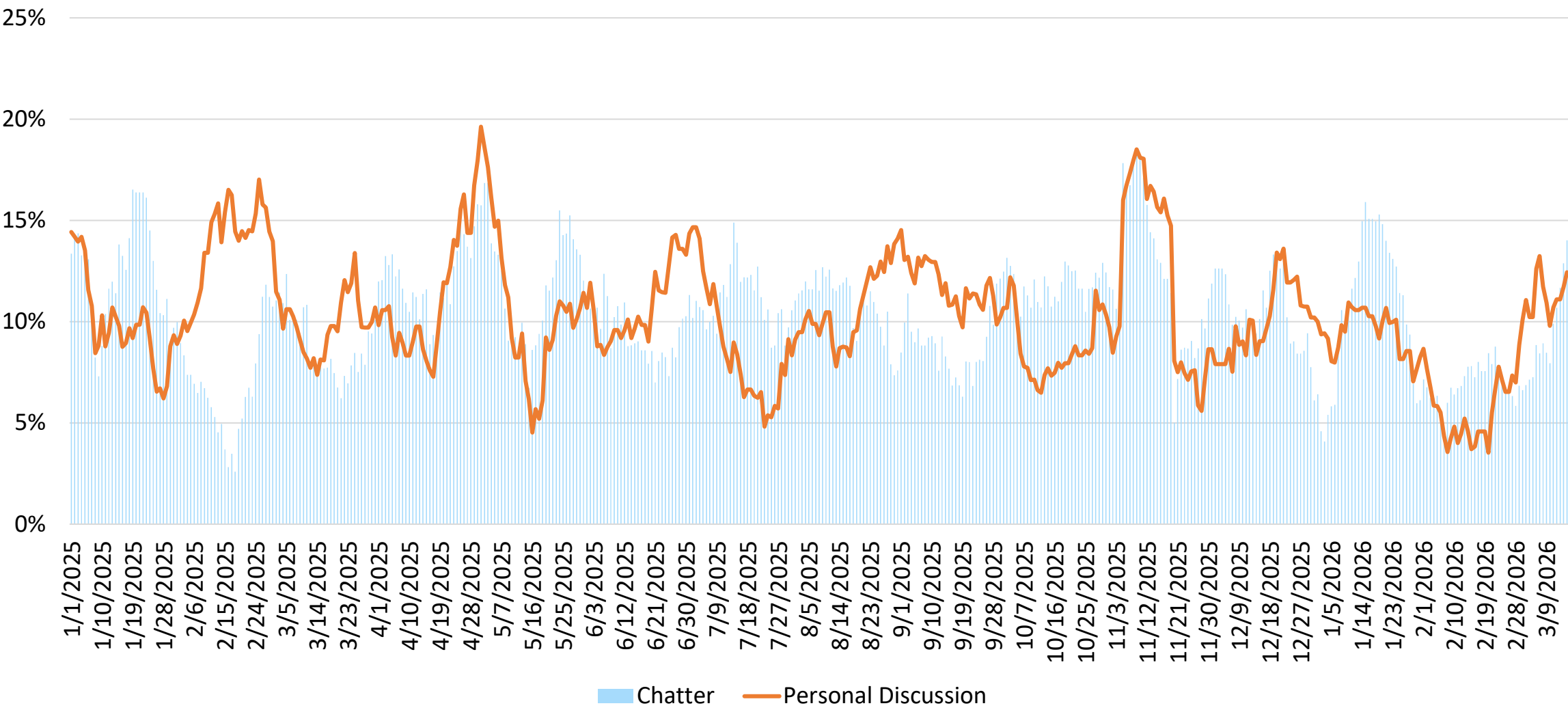

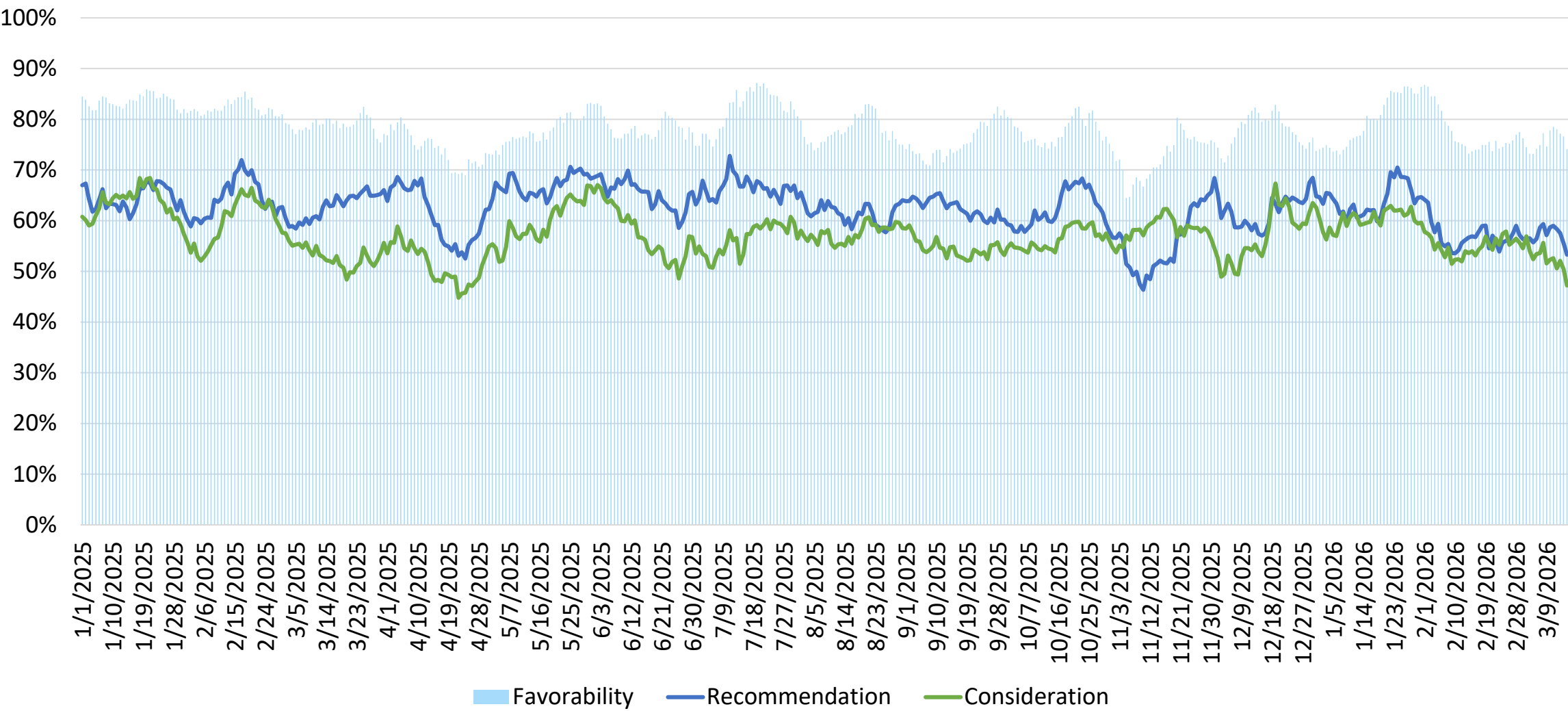
Maui – Chatter (Net) and Personal Discussion U.S. Two-Week Moving Average

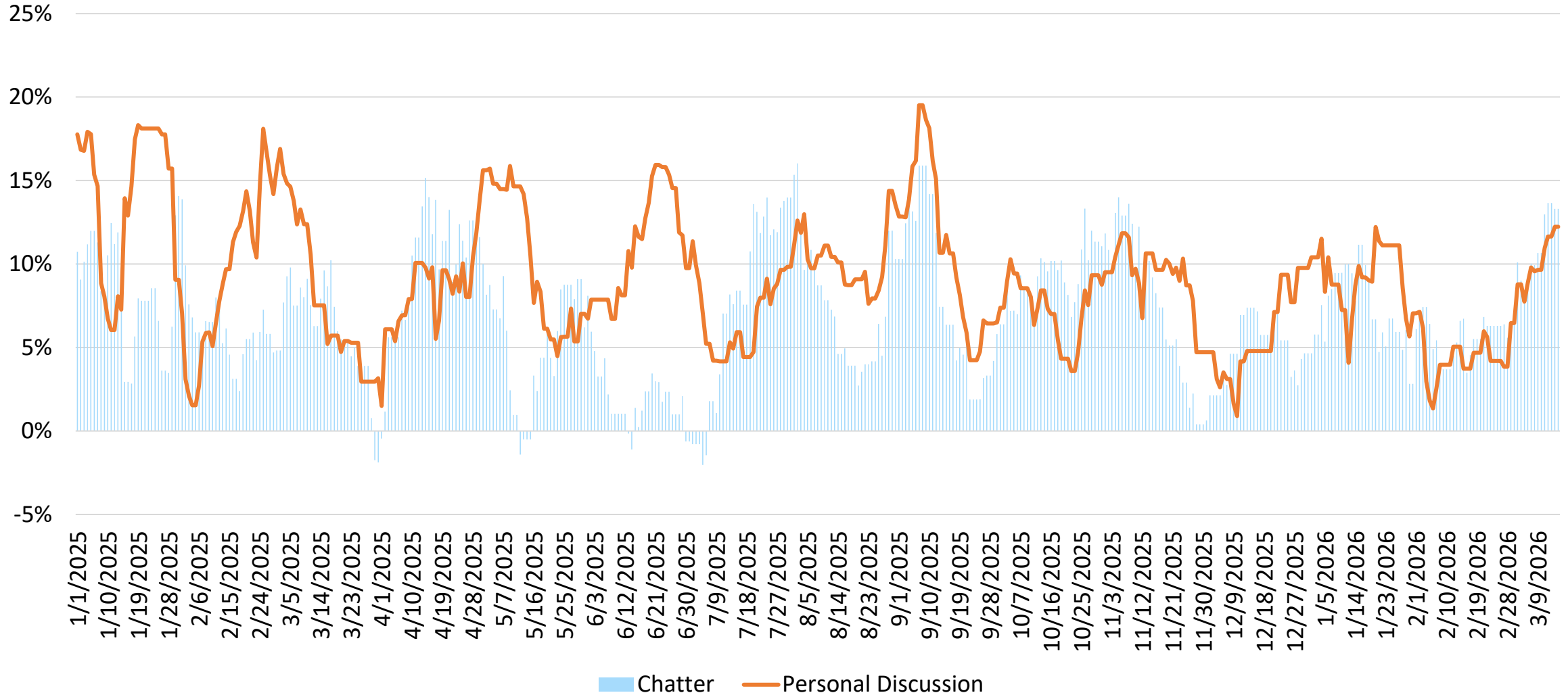

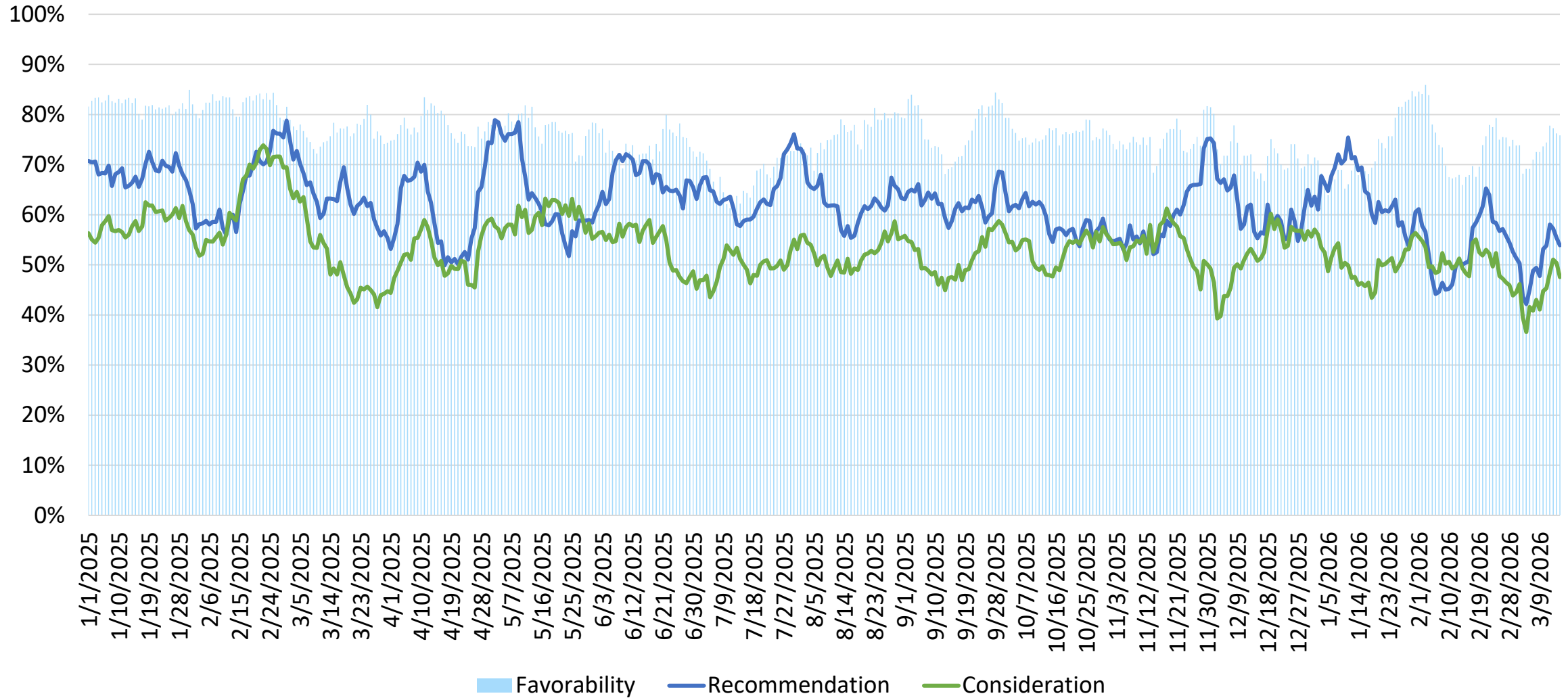

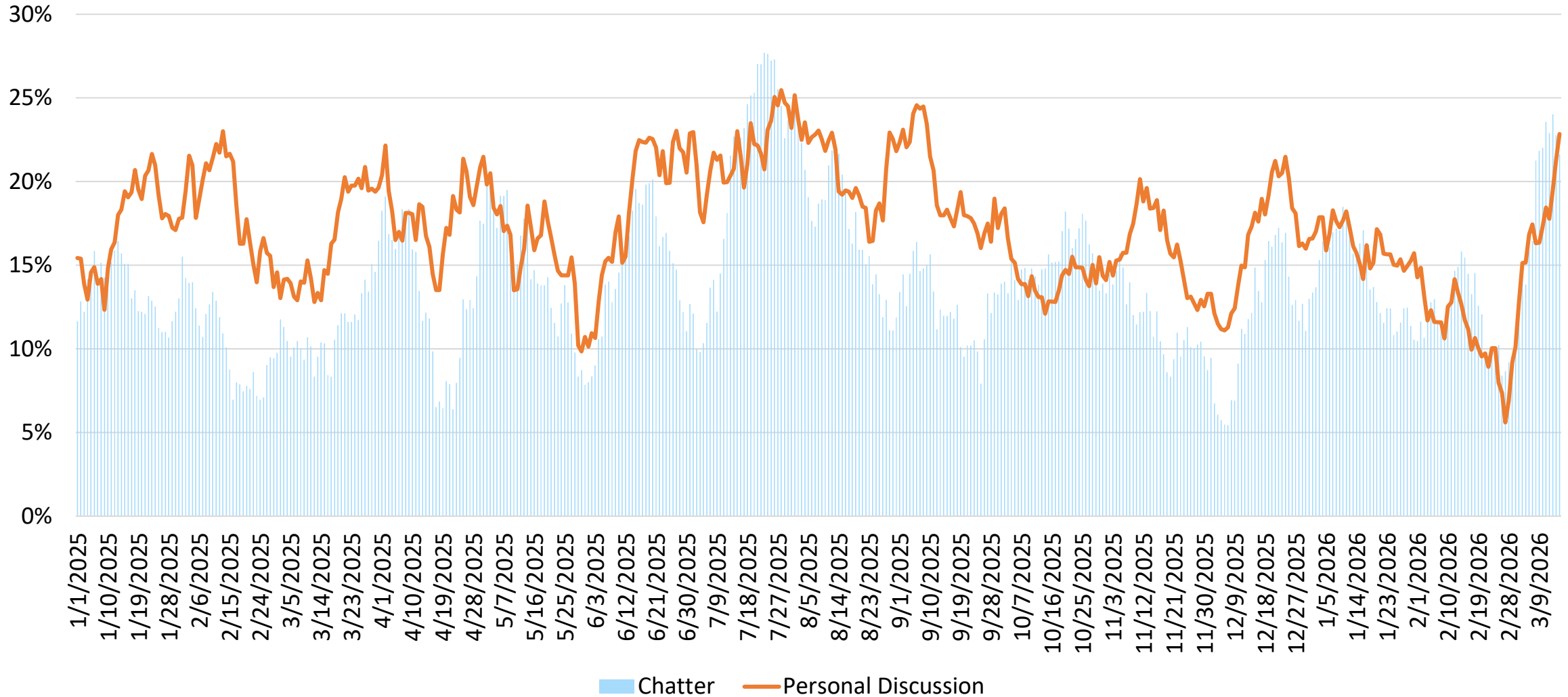

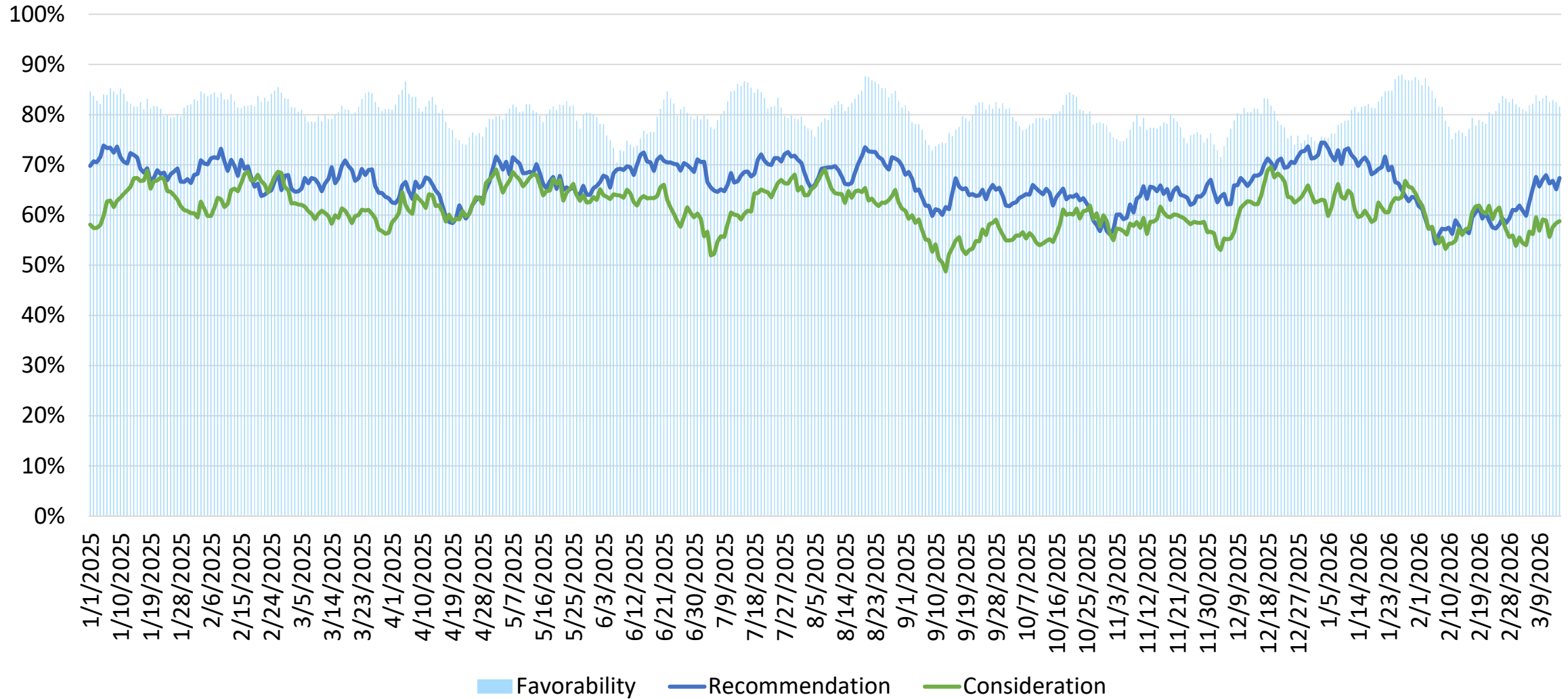
